3.1B SCHOOL-OWNED TECHNOLOGY USE POLICY

School-owned technology may be loaned to students for use on and off-campus solely to complete school-related assignments and tasks and dive deeper into the inquiry of such assignments and tasks. Guidelines for such use shall be set by the Executive Director in conjunction with the Technology teacher. Any student that borrows school-owned technology, as well as his/her parent or guardian must read, understand and sign the Use Agreement in effect at the time the student borrows the technology and abide by its terms, as well as Scholars Academy Internet Safety and Acceptable Use Policies, the Student Handbook, Google Apps for Education Responsible Use Guidelines and any other Scholars Academy governing policies and documents. Failure to uphold technology and student conduct policies will result in, but not limited to, disciplinary consequences, privileges revoked and/or financial charges applied as outlined in the Use Agreement, handbook, policy or document.
