## Compliance to Healthy Youth Act:

- To provide pupils with the knowledge and skills necessary to protect their sexual and reproductive health from HIV and other sexually transmitted infections and from unintended pregnancy
- To provide pupils with the knowledge and skills they need to develop healthy attitudes concerning adolescent growth and development, body image, gender, sexual orientation, relationships, marriage, and family
- To promote understanding of sexuality as a normal part of human development
- To ensure pupils receive integrated, comprehensive, accurate, and unbiased sexual health and HIV prevention instruction and provide educators with clear tools and guidance to accomplish that end
- To provide pupils with the knowledge and skills necessary to have healthy, positive, and safe relationships and behaviors

#### **Next Steps and Ask**



Middle School: Continue to use Planned Parenthood as a vendor to meet the requirement for compliance.

<u>Upper School:</u> Outsource to vendor (ex: Cardea who utilizes 3R's curriculum) for 2020-21 school year AND attend online/in-person during 2020-21 school year for an autonomous 2021-22 rollout

## **Math Update**



- -Administered all 3 interim assessments
- -Implemented 2 out of 3 data cycles
- -Teachers are continuing to implement our online curriculum in math
- -Most commonly used distance learning tool in math is Screencastify & Zoom

## **Identified Math Need**



Assessment Type	Purpose	Tool
Interim Assessment	Assess standards that were taught on an interim basis to inform teaching and learning of Grade Level Standards.	MS: ANet US: IAB
Summative Assessment	Tests the entire year's standards to inform grade level growth.	SBAC
Adaptive Diagnostic Test	Tests for foundational skill gaps and informs intervention.	Proposed MS/US: IXL

#### **Pilot**



#### **Overview:**

- 60 days (January-February)
- Grades 5, 7, Algebra 1 and Geometry
- 6 Teachers; 275 Students

#### **Quantitative Data:**

- 52,000 questions were answered
- Reached proficiency in 1,284 skills
- Reached mastery in 949 skills

#### Takeaways:

- Teachers who coupled the use of iXL with a mini lesson had far more engagement with the program.
- Teachers who assigned grade-level skills were able to give students the opportunity to practice content learned in core day/reviewed in the intervention block. The program focuses on math fluency which is an area of need.
- Framing and culture building around the purpose of the assessment/personalized learning tool is key.

#### **Discussion | Impact of COVID-19**



Essential Question: To what degree will COVID-19 impact our current juniors and seniors?

#### **Juniors**

- The impact of COVID-19 on college access programming available to juniors is marginal.
- While University of California has suspended standardized testing requirements, the accommodation does not preclude students from taking the SAT or ACT and submitting scores if they are able.

#### **Seniors**

- We anticipate that college-going seniors will lean toward attending local institutions.
- We are considering a proposal to the Board that would temporarily ease graduation requirements to state mandated minimums for seniors who are in danger of not graduating.

#### Agreement and Approval | AP Breakthrough



AP Breakthrough is a three-year plan to increase exam scores. It proposes new features to our current Advanced Placement program:

#### Proposed new features

- AP Vertical Teaming
- AP Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)
- AP Family Night
- AP Boot Camp

#### Impact of Vertical Teaming and PLCs

- Currently, vertical alignment and PLCs are focused on SBAC, Common Core, and Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS)
- AP Breakthrough would add AP as another dimension
