100% Voting Campaign Element: Murmuration

Our Campaign will Leverage Murmuration to Target our Voter Registration and Outreach

- We will conduct targeted voter registration of charter teachers, staff, families and alumni - using Murmuration & Oakland voter file
- We will educate and engage our existing and prospective voters so they can use their voice in the November elections - including the vital school board elections!
- We can set goals and track progress through Murmuration M{insight} tools



How does the Murmuration + FIA + Oakland Charter Schools partnership work?

- FIA holds a "parent" contract with Murmuration and **pays all costs** for accessing the Oakland voter file and Murmuration tools for the 100% Voting Campaign
- All Oakland charter schools are eligible to hold a "child" account through the FIA account at no cost and are able to access Oakland voter file and Murmuration tools
- Oakland charter schools can also opt to open their own Murmuration account the fee is about \$6K per school/network
- Schools will be able to identify which school parents/staff are registered to vote and their likelihood of voting so that voter registration and outreach efforts can be targeted

Share Your School Directory Information via CSV File

- Sign and submit the data agreement to <u>fiaoakland@gmail.com</u> by July
- Send your Parent directory information to <u>fiaoakland@gmail.com</u> in a
 CSV format by July 20 (or identify a point person to do so).
- CSV file should include: Both Parents First and Last Name, Phone,
 Cell Phone, Address, Email, Primary Language, School CMO/District
 Name, School Name.
- Optional: Identify a point person who will be the contact for the directory information sharing.

School Best Practices - Sharing Directory Information

- Each year, schools are required to provide written notice of what the school has defined as "directory information" to their families. In this case it is "parent first/last name, phone, address and primary language". This is generally provided as part of the school's general notification of rights under FERPA.
- Sharing directory information does not require family opt in, but does provide a family the option to opt-out. Schools are asked to keep track of opt-out's
