

#### Road to Reopening

- Alameda County was recently moved into the state's Red Tier due an improvement in the County's Covid indicators
  - o If we remain in the red tier for two weeks, we will receive more guidance from public health officials about what is allowable regarding re-opening
  - Oakland COVID indicators vary widely by zip code and do not necessarily match with Alameda County data
  - Some families will not consider any in-person options while others are ready for any opportunity for in-person learning.
  - Creating a Clear Draft Plan with the Academic Committee
    - In collaboration with the academic committee, school administration is putting together clear criteria for phased reopening that includes:
      - COVID cases criteria by zip codes we serve
      - Criteria for return to Learning Everywhere
      - Facility preparation, maintenance and sanitation
      - Staff and community agreements and collaboration
