- Supporting the objectives of the organization;
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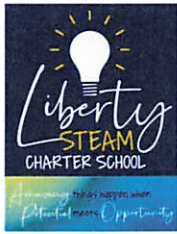
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- Speak for, or on behalf of, the organization unless specifically authorized to do so, and this includes making statements on social media.
