Section 7000 PROPERTY

Title GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS

Code 7230

Status Active

Legal I.C. 20-26-7-6 et seq.

Adopted November 17, 2020

The Board is duly appreciative of public interest in and good will toward the schools manifested through gifts, grants, and bequests. The Board reserves the right, however, to specify the manner in which gifts are made; to define the type of gift, grant, or bequest which it considers appropriate; and to reject those which it deems inappropriate or unsuitable. If accepted, the Board will attempt to carry out the wishes of the donor.

As a general policy, neither the facilities, staff, nor students of the schools, the school system, nor any part thereof shall be employed in any manner to actively advertise or otherwise promote the interest of any commercial or other non-school agency or organization, except upon the approval of the Board. The Director of Advancement and Engagement may accept a gift or property on the Board's behalf bearing the name of a commercial agency providing the property is supplementary or beneficial to the program of the schools and is not a distraction to the general school setting. The Director of Advancement and Engagement may also cooperate with certain types of non-profit organizations in this regard provided that such cooperation will not restrict, impair or disrupt the educational program of the school.

All property placed in a school of the Board as a gift by any individual, parent teacher organization, or any group for the use of the school shall become the property of the Board. So long as any such property may be used advantageously in the school in which it is initially placed, it shall be retained in such school.



However, when such use is no longer deemed by the Board to be advantageous, or the facility will no longer be used for school purposes, the Principal shall recommend to the Board to sell, move or dispose of such property in such a manner as, in his/her opinion, will best serve the interests of its schools.

Any equipment purchased by an organization for use in the school or at a school-related event shall be submitted to the Board, prior to purchase, so it can determine if the school would incur any liability by its use.

The Board reserves the right to not accept such liability and thus deny the use of the equipment by students and school employees.
