There are three (3) categories of foreign students who are considered resident students who are entitled to a free education in a specific school in Indiana.

They are:

- A. Students from any foreign country living within Edison School of the Arts boundaries who are in this country on an approved foreign exchange program.
- B. Students from Southeast Asian countries who have a family or organization sponsor living within the Edison School of the Arts boundaries.
- C. Minor dependents of any foreign family which is legitimately in this country and residing within the Edison School of the Arts boundaries.

Admission of Non-Resident Foreign Students

With the exception of the three (3) categories of foreign students, no foreign student may be enrolled in any Edison School of the Arts program without paying

cash tuition. Any student requesting to enroll must present documentation verified by the local immigration officer that the student is in this city legally.

Any foreign student who is admitted in any program offered by Edison School of the Arts that is fully funded by the State of Indiana will not be counted and reported to the State for reimbursement.
