Title: BOARD – CEO, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR RELATIONSHIP

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The Edison School of the Arts Board believes that, in general, it is the primary duty of the Board to establish policies and that of the CEO, Executive Director to administer such policies. Policy should not be originated or changed without the input of the CEO, Executive Director. The CEO, Executive Director should be given the latitude to determine the best method of implementing the policies of the Board.

The CEO, Executive Director, as the chief administrator of the school, is the primary professional advisor to the Board. S/He is responsible for the development, supervision, and operation of the school program and facilities. His/Her methods should be made known to the staff through the administrative guidelines of the school.

The Board shall retain oversight supervision of such guidelines.

The Edison School of the Arts Board is responsible for determining the success of the CEO, Executive Director in meeting the goals established by the Board through annual evaluations of the CEO, Executive Director's performance. The Board, in formulating its position with regard to the performance of the CEO, Executive Director, shall rely, whenever possible, on the objective outcomes of its evaluations rather than on subjective opinions.
