Elementary School Goals, Glows, Grows

Goal:

- 80% of students in grades K-4 will be reading on or above grade level at the end of the school year.

Glows:

- Students in 2nd-4th are on track to meet or come close to our goal of 80%
- Teachers found ways to administer these one on one assessments, even while remote, for each student

Grows:

- Students in grades K and 1 are not close to meeting this goal at this time
- We have PD planned for this spring, as well as a plan for our Workshop time in the fall to address these needs (resources, staffing, strategies, etc)

Middle School Goals, Glows, Grows

Goals

- 5% Average student growth in Math
- 4% Average student growth in Language Arts: Language Usage
- 4% Average student growth in Language Arts: Reading
- Fall 2021 RTI intervention time in Math and ELA implemented with students sorted into groups based on needs identified in MAP testing

Glows

- Two rounds of MAP testing administered, round three scheduled for June. We are on track to establish intervention groups in term 1 for 2021-2022 school year.
- 5.25% Average student growth in Language Arts reading
 - Grades 5-8 exceeded national projections for student growth published by NWEA
 - Small group reading instruction at each grade level with a reading interventionist.

Grows

- -2% growth in Language Arts: Language Usage in the MS
- 2.75% average student growth MS math scores

High School Goals, Glows, Grows

Goals:

- Ten point increase in SAT scores compared to last test cycle
- Complete HS scheduling process by the last day of the school year

Glows:

- Integration of SAT prep (Khan Academy) into math and English departments
- Improved and streamlined scheduling process - COVID helped!
- Increased stakeholder input - eighth grade teachers, “sending” teachers, SPED administrators and AP teachers
- Development of Algebra 1+ resources for rising ninth graders

Grows:

- Recruitment of students to sit for SATs
- Development of some sort of DDMs to replace MCAS now that the CD has been waived for class of '22
- Continue to find areas of efficiency in scheduling process to speed up timeline
