Classroom Placement Process

New System of Classroom Placements

- Teachers created a student data snapshot for every students
- Levels met to discuss students who are transitioning to the next level (eg Primary and LE to discuss primary to LE placements)
- Teachers discussed each student and what kind of supports are useful for them!
- Teachers in the "receiving" levels described their student communities and decided on which classroom's student community would be the best fit for each student
- Students were then matched to student communities, not teachers.

New System of Classroom Placements

 This year Parents and students will be notified of classroom placements in early August (mostly due to our switch in Student Information Systems!)

 By next year this system will allow us to notify families of classroom placements much earlier and hopefully by the end of the previous school year!

What is the LCAP?

The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a compliance document that all Local Education Agencies (LEAs) complete in order to share their goals, actions they plan to take towards these goals and resources they allocate to the support of specific student populations.

It is also used as reflection tool for LEA's to share successes and challenges!

GOAL 3: Broad Goal

 All UMCS staff receive regular coaching and mentoring and feel sustained in their roles, every classroom has a fully trained Montessori teacher, and classrooms are each a fully prepared learning environment.

 Teacher Support, Instructional Materials, Technology for Staff

GOAL 4: Maintenance Goal

 Continue to build strong school community-wide and families-wide engagement; examine and interrogate school procedures and policies to surface and address racist practices or behaviors in the ongoing effort to model being an anti-racist school and community.
