

Students met with success writing code to play a game. Kindergarteners and First Graders moved Kodable through a series of mazes by adding arrows to allow Kodable to move.



Congratulations to these outstanding members of the Foxborough Regional Charter School Class of 2021!



#### Recruitment and Retention

- 1. A lot of movement and progress, but not sure about impact
- 2. Data collection and analysis will start next week
- 3. Assigned colleges to subcommittee members to engage college students
- 4. Applying for a diversification group with Mike Cournoyer's help
- 5. Mass Diversity network meeting next week
- 6. Currently all job descriptions include cultural proficiency as a criteria of employment
- 7. The group will work on the following three items to increase impact on the school community:
  - a. Develop standard interview questions and scenarios and develop rubrics
  - b. Review hiring recruitment and policies for unintentional bias
  - c. Anti-bias training for all staff, but most importantly for any staff participating in hiring committees.

#### Curriculum

- 1. Moving in the right direction
- 2. Supporting teachers
- 3. Data collection does take time it's just a starting point
- 4. A lot of room to grow
- 5. Focused right now on ELA and math, phonics in ES
- 6. Looking at it from a social justice lens and multicultural lens
- 7. Market has changed in what we can find in text (wider array with a wider lens)
- 8. Train staff on how to analyze materials for cultural responsiveness
- 9. Beginning stages of assessing materials (instructional and curriculum materials)
- 10. New MS Math curriculum is making an impact on our students and teachers



# Family Engagement

- 1. No impact on school community yet
- 2. Virtual programming in classrooms was hard and is not a good fit
- 3. Parent to parent network info session at the end of the month forming group in April so they can start next year.
- 4. Parent advisory group—all three schools. They bring feedback to us; provide a contact for other parents; they are the bridge between us and the parents
  - a. One parent for every ES grade, 3 MS parents, and 2 HS parents
- 5. We have not conducted any parent surveys about school climate, but the committee will work on this next because we identified this as a need.

### **Professional Development**

- 1. We are making an impact on our school community.
- 2. We have added cultural proficiency in performance evaluations for teachers, but we need to expand that to all staff to have a greater impact.
- 3. Most of our teachers have earned their EL endorsement thanks to Amanda Goddard's efforts in securing an opportunity for our staff to take the course at our school (subsequently went to zoom back in March). We also provided tuition reimbursement to staff and were able to use grant funds to supplement.
- 4. Kathleen Foley's PD yearlong course has been a success. We will be offering it during the summers too. This cohort being trained this year has felt more comfortable being vulnerable in front of their peers while sharing their thoughts. This may be attributed to the DEI all staff trainings on Wednesdays.
- 5. We need to find a balance between DEI training and time for staff to collaborate on Wednesdays

### Student Engagement

- 1. Our newest committee although we have met on a regular basis this year, we had not succeeded in recruiting students to be members of the subcommittee until our last meeting in late December. Therefore, our work begins now!
- 2. In our last meeting, students expressed they have not been receiving the communication that their families receive.
- 3. They would also like to interact more with their peers albeit virtually for social purposes only. They would also like more college related activities and more info on part-time job opportunities.
