




## 2020-21 Year-End Update

Nearly 15% increase in State SPED

LCFF S&C revenue to match spending

Charter term automatically extended by two years

No STRS or PERS relief

# **Expanded Learning Opportunities**



\$1.75B for classroom based TK-6 UP

\$1,170 per UP for LEAs over 80%

Minimum grant of \$50k

For 21-22, offer to all UP, provide to >50% of UP

For 22-23, offer to all students, provide to all who request

### **One Time Funding**



#### Educator Effectiveness


- \$1.5B, estimate of \$2,375 per FTE
- Five-year spending time frame
- Plan to be adopted by December 30, 2021

TK Planning

- \$200M to establish relationships with Pre-K providers, PD, recruit/hire, materials
- \$100k minimum grant for LEAs that offer K
- Plan to be adopted by June 30, 2022


