YSCS has placed all but 6 of its students in		
high schools. Students were placed in 4		
catholic schools, 11 charter, 1 independent		
and a number of District high schools.		
YSCS has retained 90%+ of its staff for next		
year and thanks to Federal funding will be		
adding positions to address the needs of the		
school community in light of COVID and		
associated learning impact. It will also offer		
summer school to all students.

YSCS were to receive approval to expand its		
student body, the expanded facility could		
serve up to an additional 100 students.
