### III. DISCUSSION TOPICS

## 1. Executive Director Updates

- Update from Math and Reading Content Teams- Mr. Amenda opened with RELA/Content team introductions. Ms. Birnkrant and Ms. Smith shared culture and curriculum updates since the last meeting. They shared initiatives and goals, explained the "wins" and "raise the bars". "Wins" include: the average paycheck has been over \$100, student support protocol is positive, teachers have been using systems for strong management, there has been an increased use of chants and cheers, there is a positive school culture as a whole, and staff has been using the Kickboard system to drive practices and needs of students. "Raise the bars" include: uniforms, gum chewing, students without hallway passes, and improved transitions between classes. They also shared that pushing rigorous instructions in the classroom, using data on a regular basis, and consistent weekly coaching is showing progress and growth across staff and students. They then framed the structure of the content leads to drive student achievement and instructional leadership. Math Content Lead, Ms. Frank, talked about using IXL and classroom structure, and how content is being utilized across all grades. Reading Content Lead, Ms. Barbati, talked about the ANet structure and how it is utilized in the classroom.
- b Dashboard Review/Power Goals Review- Mr. Midha began by explaining that we are on track with measuring student expectations. Mr. Amenda then went through the Power Goals and referred to the dashboard, showing that the metrics are all green. He also went through goals set from last meeting and what has been updated. The school has a 96% student attendance rate, however, the transition to public transportation caused some difficulty with tardiness.
