



- Cycle 2 Model Changes
  - Lots of small changes, but two big ones:
    - Restructured consequence system to involve parents earlier and in lower lift ways (text, calls)
    - Restructured student schedule to take away student choice
  - Setting data goals around teacher practice, student performance on Summit, cultural positivity, and disciplinary incidents.
    - Far fewer disciplinary incidents (halved lunch detentions)
  - Less student choice, more structured support
    - Mostly positive feedback, negative feedback from top 10% of students
