These graduation tracks establish set standards of expectations and achievements for satisfactory completion of requirements necessary to earn the high school diploma from Encore Jr./Sr. High School.

Due to the increased requirements for graduation in each of the graduation tracks, it is our responsibility to provide adequate time and preparation for our students to choose their graduation track, and to meet the requirements in the track they choose.

Class of 2024's graduation requirements will remain the same as the Class of 2023:

English I - 10 credits	Government/Economics - 5/5 credits
English II - 10 credits	Physical Science - 10 credits
English III - 10 credits	Biological Science - 10 credits
English IV - 10 credits	Foreign Language - 20 credits
Math - 30 credits	Fine Art - 10 credits
World History - 10 credits	Electives - 10 credits
US History - 10 credits	

**Additional requirements by the State of California:**

1. Completion of the FAFSA - starting with the class of 2023
2. Offer a semester course of Ethnic Studies beginning in the 2025-2026 school year
3. A semester course of Ethnic Studies - Required starting with the Class of 2030
