

PROPOSED Carpool Policy v.10/23

[Act 362](#) of the 2023 Regular Legislative Session requires that schools serving students in grades K-5 establish a policy and procedures for carpool and bus lines. The following policy includes minor procedural changes that meet legal requirements.

Proposed policy:

ISL conducts carpool and bus drop-offs and pick-ups on public streets adjacent to our campuses. When students are dropped off for school in the carpool or bus line, students shall remain seated and in the appropriate restraints until the vehicle or bus comes to a complete stop. If the student is in Kindergarten through Third grade, the student shall be accompanied by a school employee when walking from the vehicle until the student is in a safe location away from vehicles.

When students are picked up from school in the carpool line, students shall wait in a designated area while waiting for their vehicle or bus. Students shall not move from the pickup area until the vehicle or bus comes to a complete stop. Students in Kindergarten through Third grade shall be accompanied by a school employee while walking to and from the carpool pick-up area or the bus pick-up area.
