Dr. Eucker presented photographs from the school-wide Unity Day. There was an Under the Sea Dance, where one of the sixth grade STEM students was the DJ. The school also completed Trunk of Treat. Kindergarten began to implement a new coding program. The students were able to pilot three products. BEST Robotics took first in Colorado for the sixth straight year and were featured in the news.

Several VIPs toured the school in the month of October: Noel Ginsburg-CareerWise, Ian Bernstein- Sphero, IP Media team for video, Erin Kane-Interim DCSD superintendent.

Enrollment: 1596. Ethnic: 34%. Next school year the goal is 1850 with about 100 off campus. Open enrollment: Nov. 1.

Financial dashboard: audit is complete. No change in numbers.

Academy: meet once a month. Smooth transition from 501c3 to STEM side. Scheduled for the last Friday of every month.

Innovation Pavilion Conceptual Model: live/work/school.

The staff holiday party is scheduled for December 15<sup>th</sup>.

Board training date is scheduled for January 13<sup>th</sup>.

The board currently has two Class A director openings and is in the process of developing an application and appointment process. The Board will work on a timeline for applications and will seek League of Charter School advice and support. The application should include a resume.

The board intends to develop a draft Class A application by the January board meeting.

**VIII. TMP update- shuttle service**

Shuttle service: additional reviews with the board last year DCSD. Use an offsite drop-off parking lot. RTD will allow us to use the fourth gate.

This item has been tabled indefinitely as the service is expensive and may not be needed.

**IX. D1 partnership**

Roy and Nicole will continue negotiations with Panorama for use of space particularly during the winter. The goal to begin facility usage is January 1<sup>st</sup>.

**X. 2017-2018 Academic calendar approval**

The Board approved the 2017-2018 academic calendar.
