Background

The Student Survey was designed and administered during the spring 2020 in order to understand student perspectives in the areas of Teaching Staff, Curriculum, Culture, and Virtual Remote Learning. Student email blasts were sent out and it was announced in the student weekly newsletter. The 2019-20 survey was open for feedback from May 14th, 2020 - May 22nd, 2020. There were 115 responses. This data indicates a response rate of 9.1%.



Results and Next Steps

Overall, the results of the 2019-20 survey indicate that students are highly satisfied with the culture regarding academics (90+%), “fitting in and being respected” (84%), and having a staff member they trust (89%). In addition, 85% of students indicated that bullying was not an issue.

The following areas were identified as goals for improvement in the 2020-21 school year:

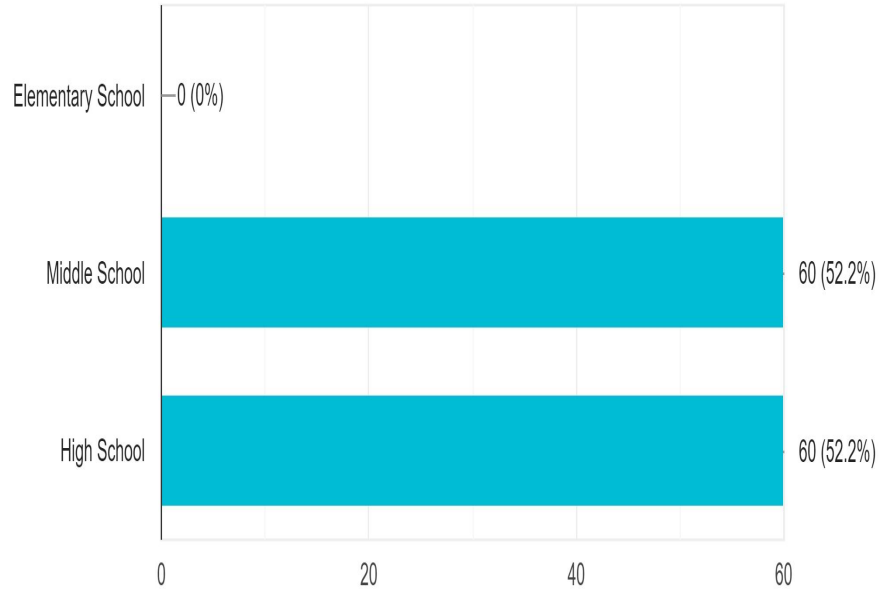
- Implementing and enforcing “fair rules” (74%)

- Problem solving techniques for working out disagreements with peers (75%), and
- Safety (81%)

A continued focus on providing opportunities for student leadership will be implemented in addition to a continued focus on the social-emotional needs of students. Implementation of restorative practices is also a focus for the 2020-21 school year.

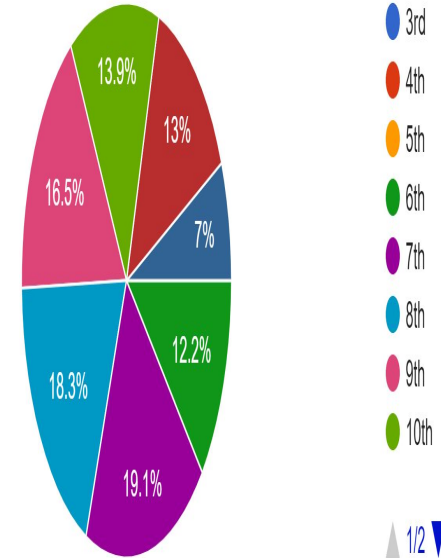

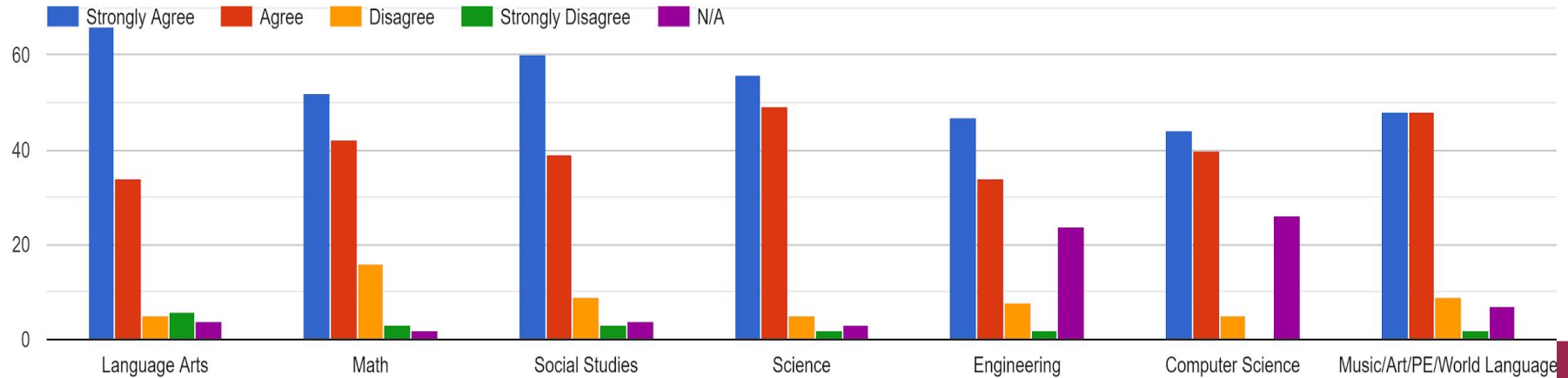

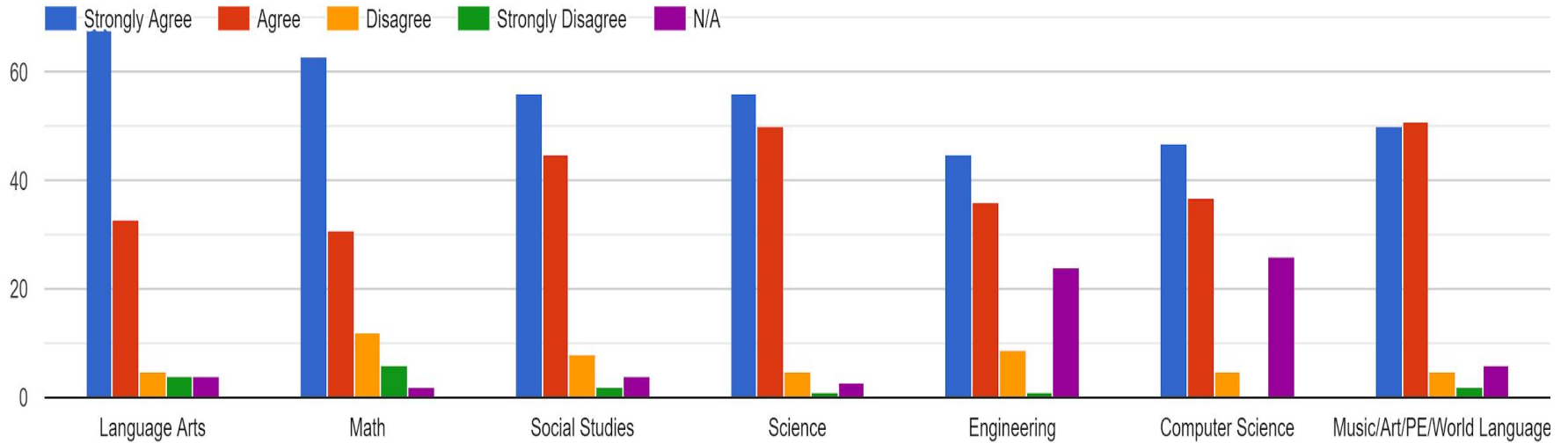

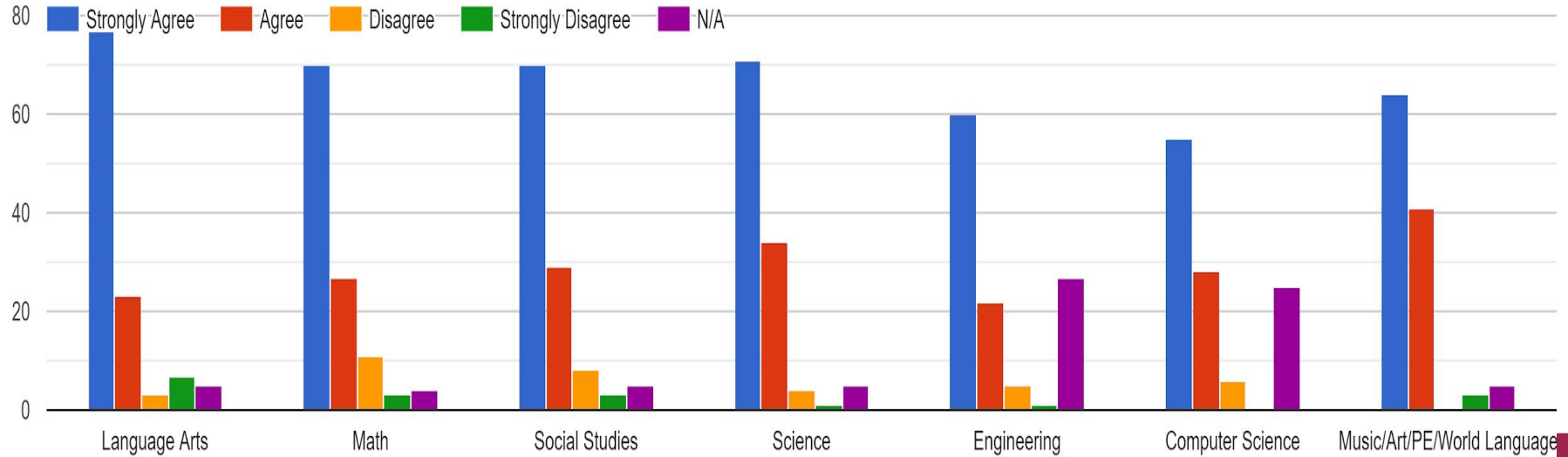
Teachers clearly communicate information regarding student expectations.



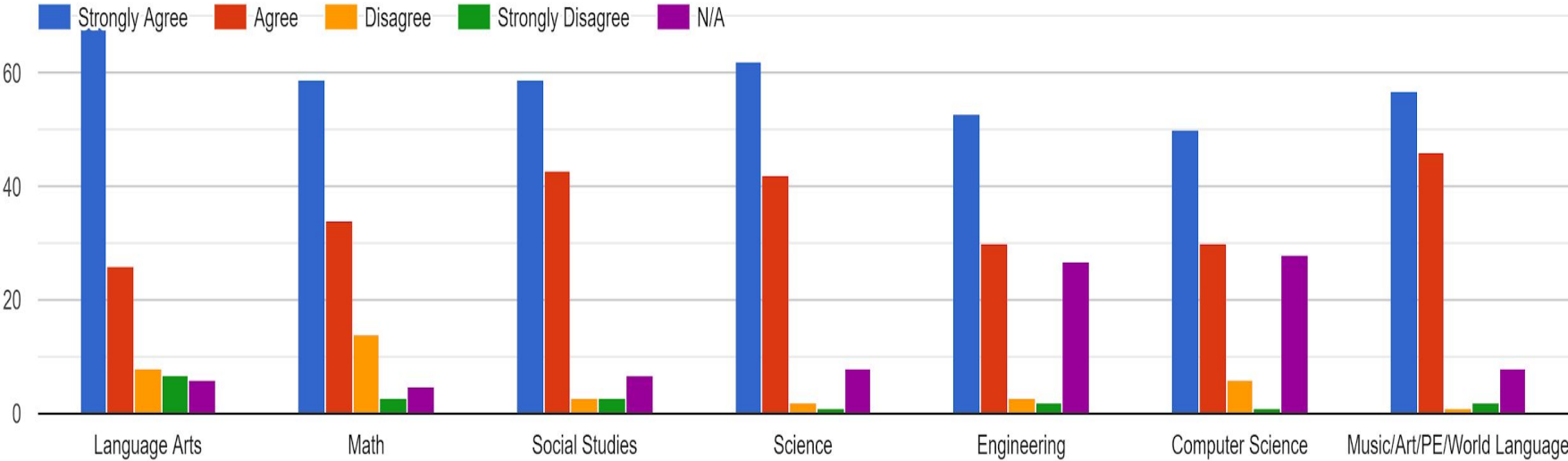
Teachers clearly communicate information related to day-to-day requirements and classroom activities.



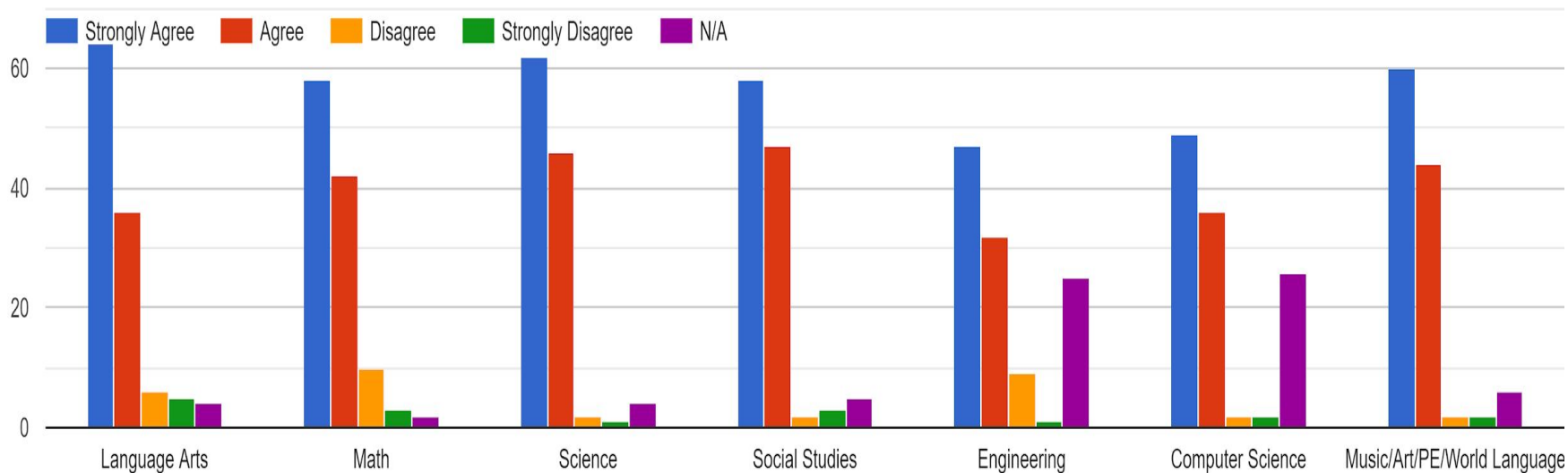
My teacher is responsive and assists with my questions and needs.



When I have class-related issues, my teacher is helpful in resolving them.



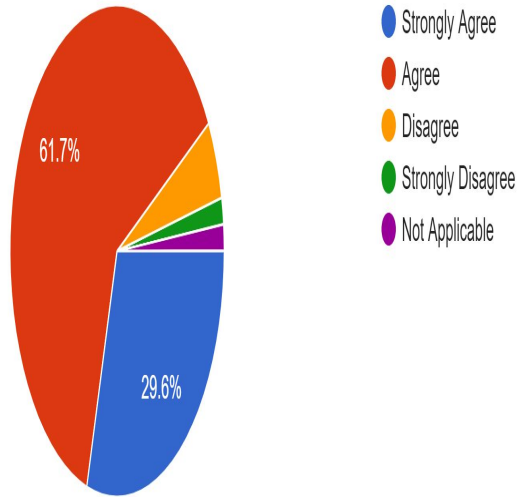
Teachers are supportive of my needs and I feel my needs are being met.

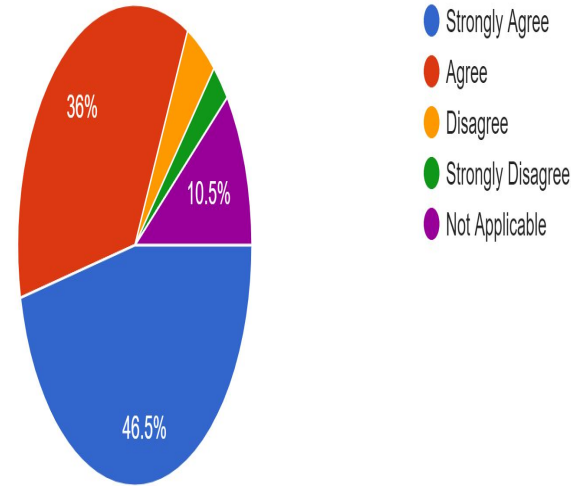
I am academically challenged through rigorous curriculum at STEM.

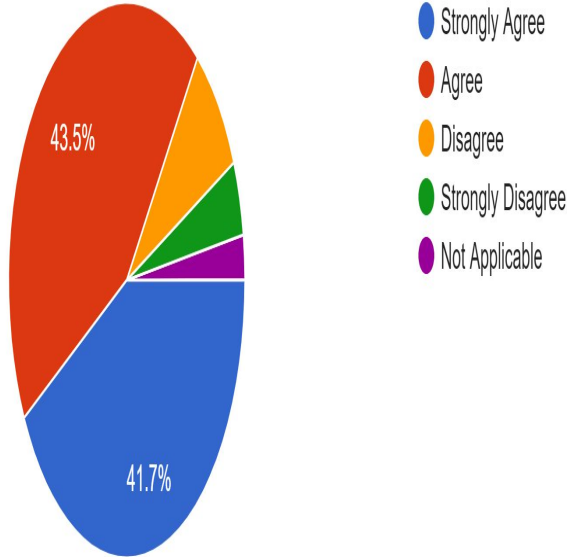
STEM is more challenging than other schools I have attended.

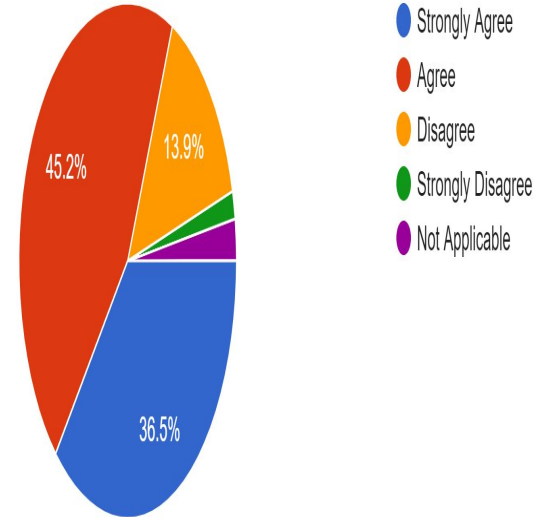

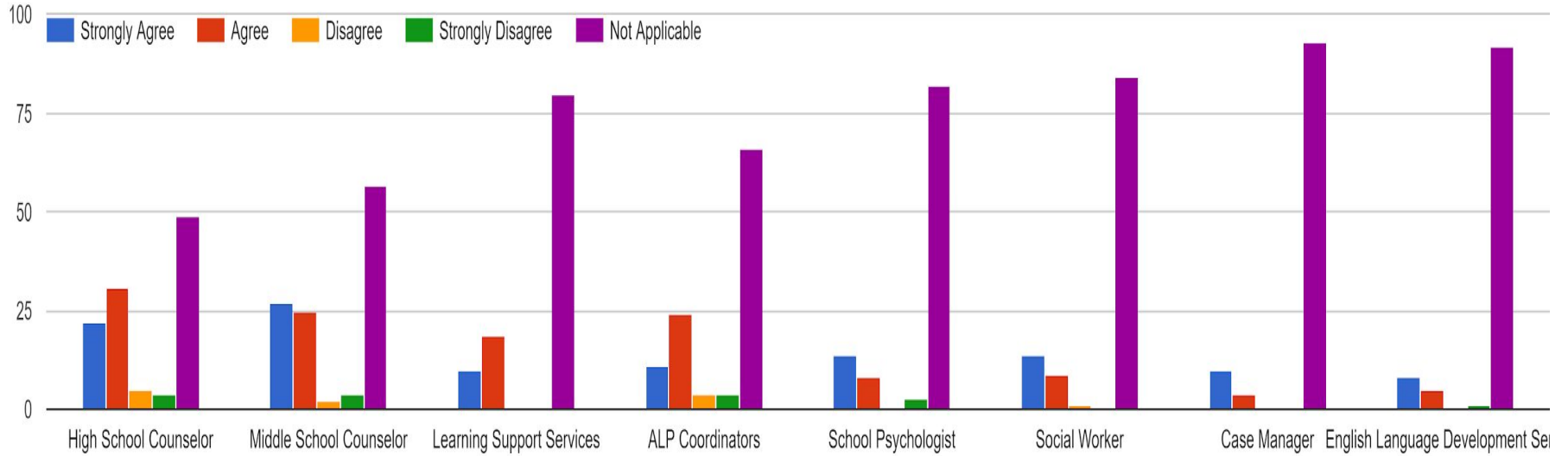


STEM concepts such as real world application, problem based learning, and integrated technology, engage me in learning.

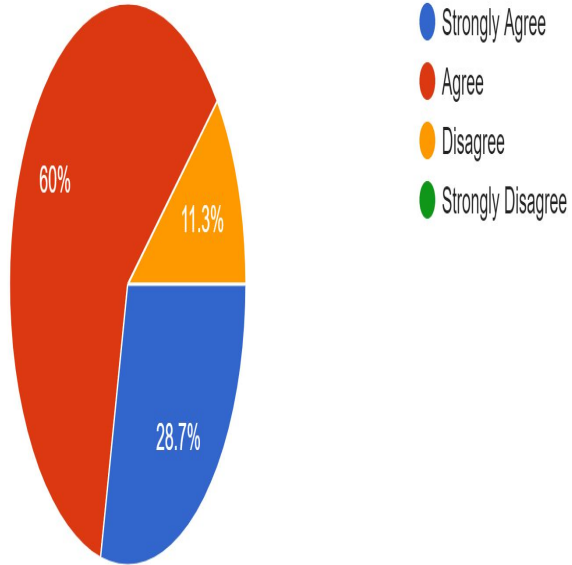

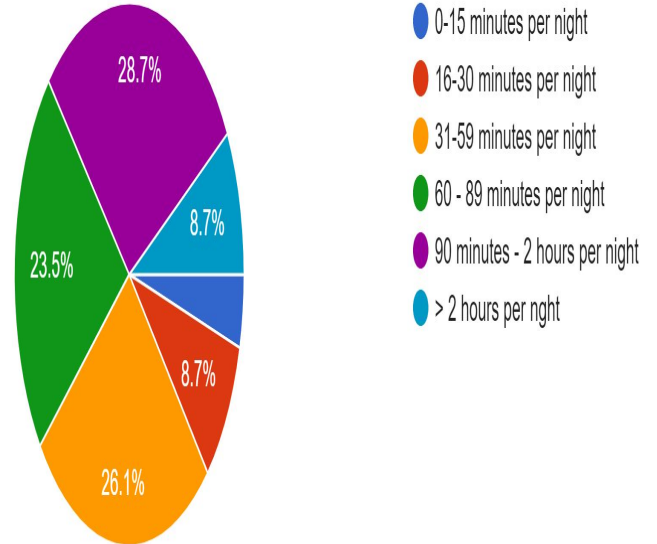
The workload is in line with the rigor that you expect from students at STEM.

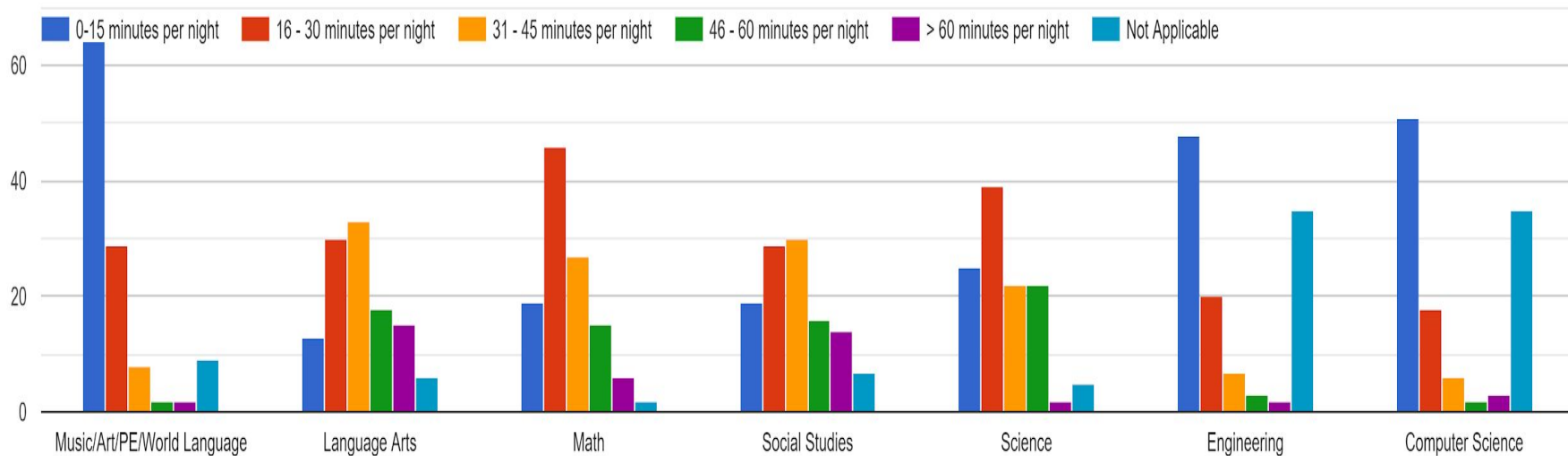


Overall, on a typical day, how much time do you spend on homework?

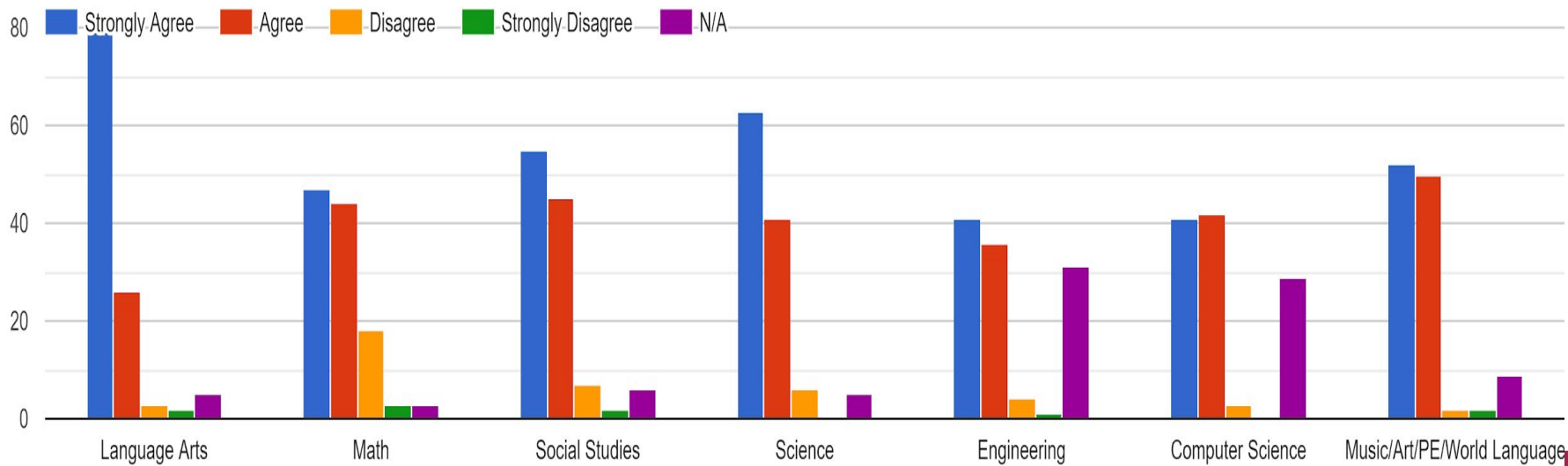

Please select the average amount of time per night that you spend on homework for each subject.

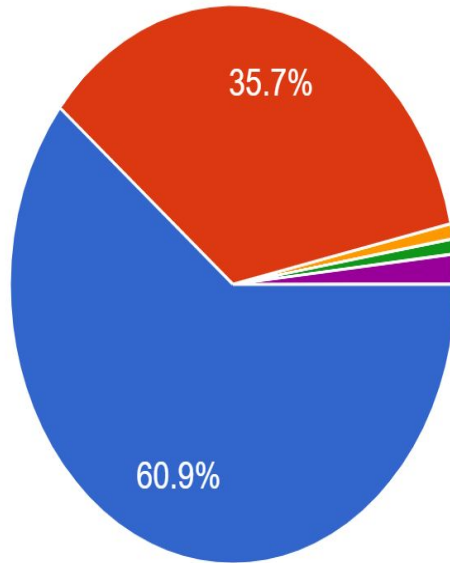


Teachers use Canvas effectively for assignment feedback.



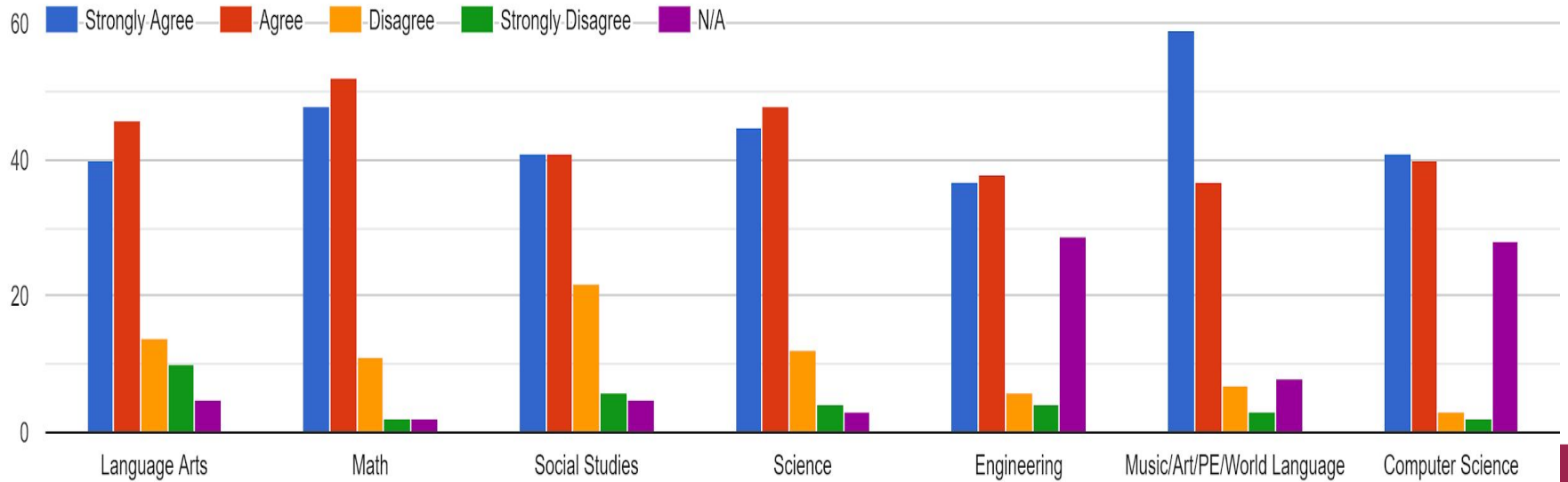
You are able to use Canvas to help assess your progress.

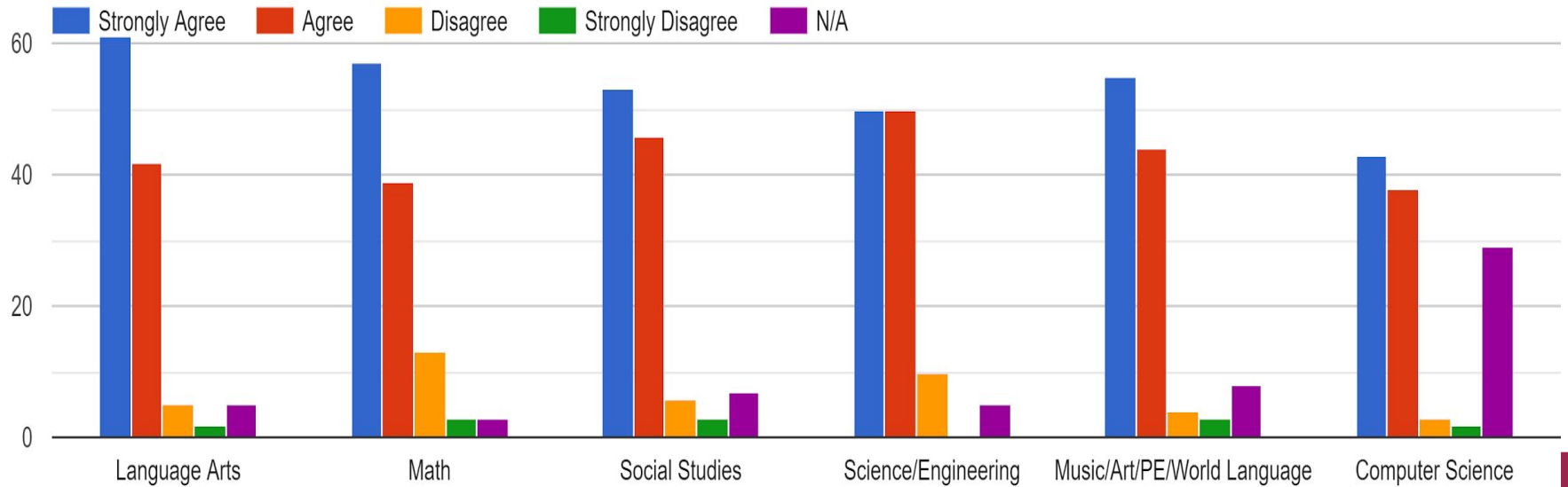

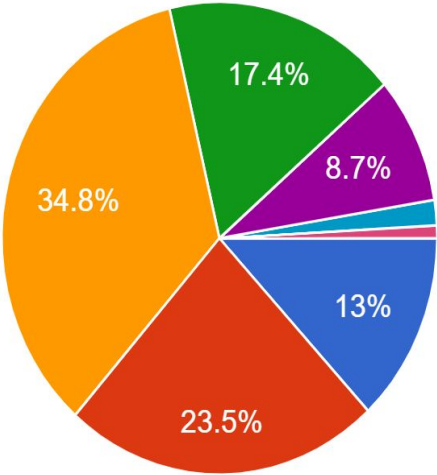

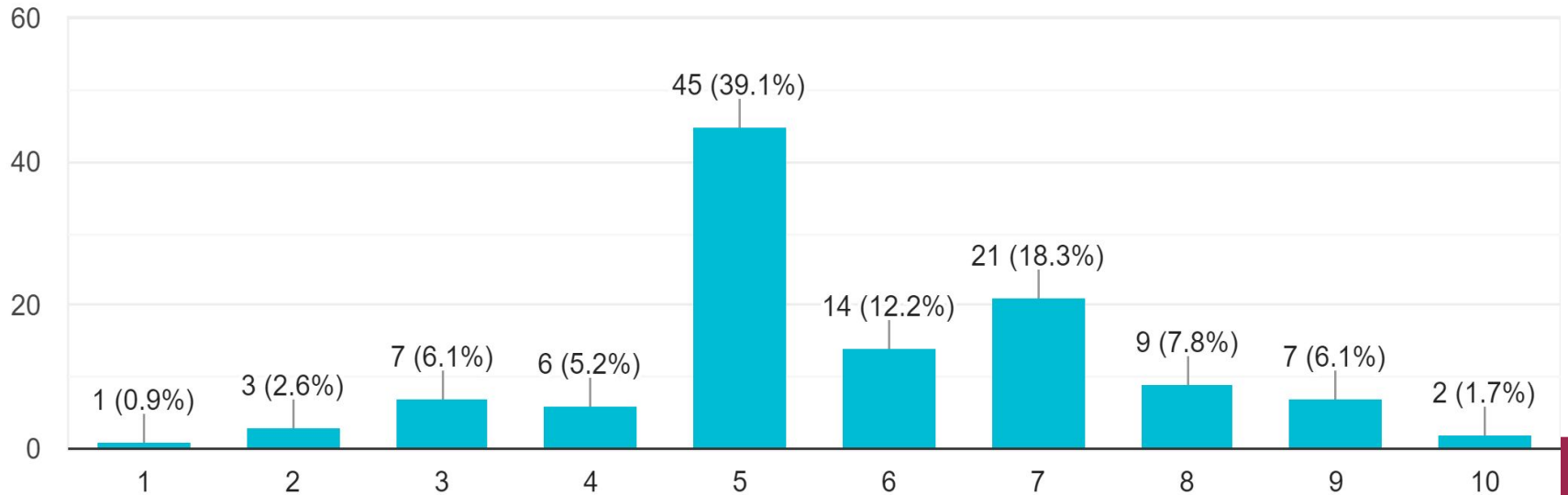

How do you feel about the amount of work you have been receiving during Virtual/Online learning?

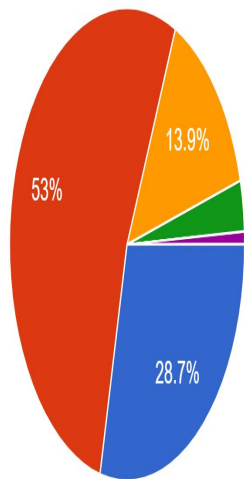

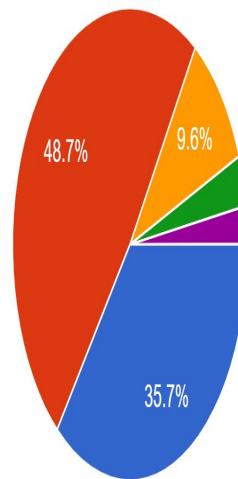

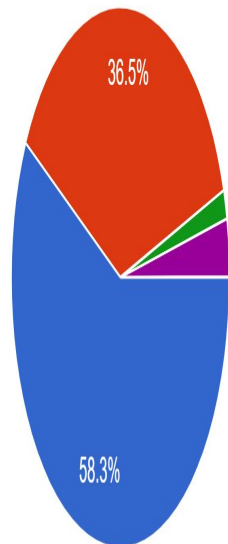

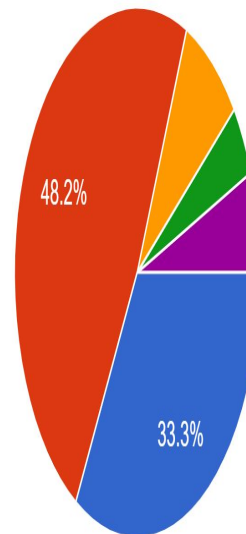

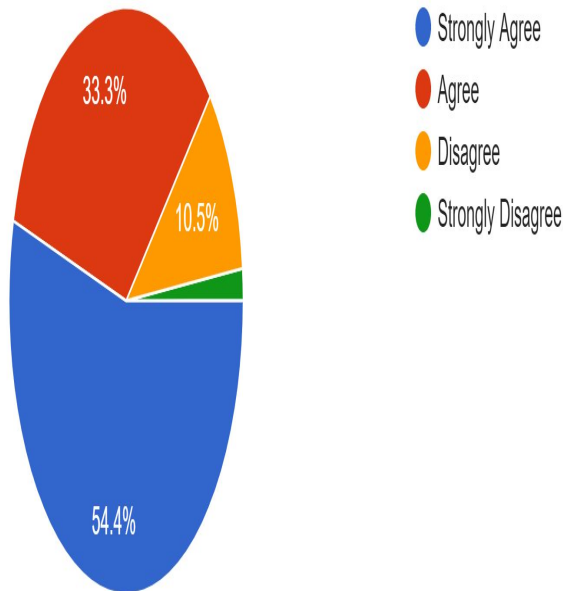

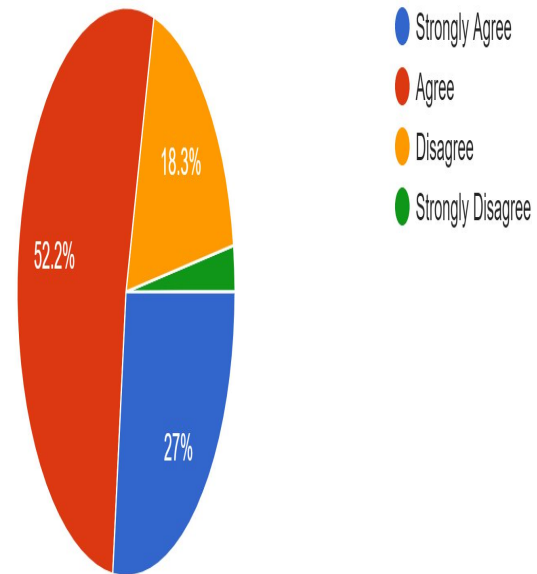
I have at least one staff member that I feel comfortable going to for help.

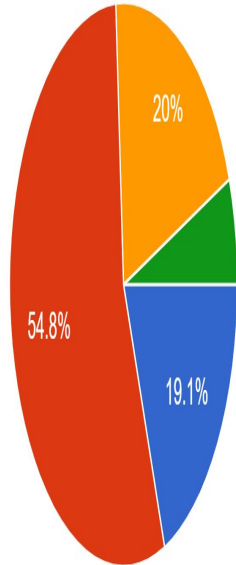

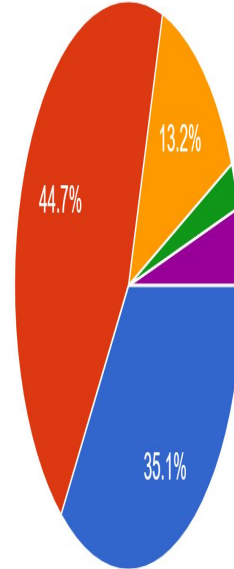

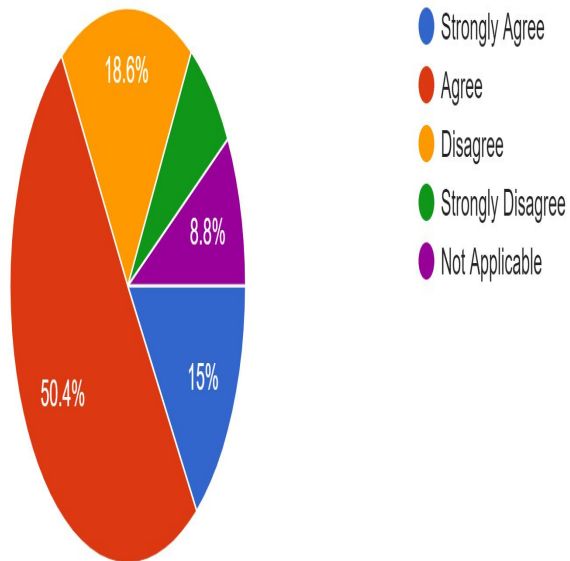
