### **Gun-Free Policy**

Alabama Aerospace and Aviation School's campuses are gun-free environments. All persons, other than authorized law enforcement personnel, are prohibited from possessing any gun or firearm on school property, buses, or at school events. The consequences for violating this policy are as follows:

#### **Students**

Violation of these procedures will result in expulsion from school, loss of the privilege of attending any regular public school in Alabama for one calendar year from the date of expulsion and referral to the criminal justice or juvenile delinquency system. The disciplinary action taken against a student with disabilities who violates these procedures shall be determined on a case-by-case basis in accordance with the requirements of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act.

#### **School Personnel**

Violation of these procedures will result in suspension and/or termination from i3 Academy schools.

#### **All Others**

Others violating these procedures will be forbidden from all school properties and events for a period up to one year or longer. Violation of these procedures by any of the above will result in immediate notification of the Bessemer City Police Department.
