# Pataula Charter Academy and Spring Creek Charter Academy Class Size Policy 

The Pataula Charter Academy, Inc. Governing Board shall be responsible for setting and adjusting Class Size Maximums for Pataula Charter Academy (PCA) and Spring Creek Charter Academy (SCCA). In keeping with the goals stated in the PCA, Inc. Bylaws to promote academic excellence, foster creativity, instill leadership skills, and prepare students for success, the Board will strive to keep class size in accordance with the recommendations found in the SREB Policy Brief on Class Size (Publication \#:12Eo2R).

PCA/SCCA may exceed the maximum enrollment only under the following conditions:

1. The Number of students retained in a Grade Level causes the excess in Maximum Enrollment for a Grade.
2. An Employee is hired that has a child wishing to enroll in a Grade Level that is at Maximum Enrollment.
3. To ensure a student is able to take a course that is needed in the event that scheduling conflicts occur that cannot otherwise be resolved.
