The following actions by Shining Rock Classical Academy (the "School") shall require advanced written consent by a parent:

- 1. The creation, sharing, or storage of a biometric scan of his or her child or the child's blood or DNA:
- 2. A video or voice recording by the School of his or her child, except if the recording will be used solely for any of the following purposes:
 - a. A safety demonstration, including one related to security and discipline on educational property.
 - b. An academic or extracurricular activity.
 - c. Classroom instruction.
 - d. Photo identification cards.
 - e. Security or surveillance of buildings, grounds, or school transportation.
 - f. For a minor child to participate in reproductive health and safety education programs, consistent with the requirements of G.S. 115C-81.30.
- 3. For a minor child to participate in any survey, analysis, or evaluation involving Protected Information of the child or child's family. Protected Information includes any of the following:
 - a. Political affiliations or beliefs of the student or the student's parent.
 - b. Mental or psychological problems of the student or the student's family.
 - c. Sex behavior or attitudes.
 - d. Illegal, antisocial, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior.
 - e. Critical appraisals of other individuals with whom respondents have close family relationships.
 - f. Legally recognized privileged or analogous relationships, such as those of lawyers, physicians, and ministers.
 - g. Religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or student's parent.
 - h. Income other than that required by law to determine eligibility for participation in a program or for receiving financial assistance under such program.

At least ten days before the survey's administration, the School shall make available to parents and adult students, electronically and in person, (1) the process for providing consent to participate and (2) the full text of the protected information survey.

Students shall be permitted to participate in a protected information survey with the parent's or adult student's prior written or electronic consent.
