B. Overview of Fall 2022 MAP Data

Screener/Aimsweb -- First grade and Kindergarten students flagged for being below average in MAP reading fluency. 4 in first and 7 in kindergarten were in the below average reading fluency (dyslexia).

Students in red for both ELA and Math are receiving learning assistance and power 30.

Mark asks for longitudinal data for the black/white achievement gaps. Rhiannen - need a better way to track this data.

C. Parent Survey Data from May 2022

187 responses to the 2022 Parent/Caregiver survey.

The parents responding are 80% white...how can we get this more evenly distributed?

Question 42: after school and enrichment -- need to focus on a separate survey for this.

What are some of the ways we can get responses from our underrepresented families?
