II. Educational Excellence

A. Winter MAP Review

Our overall mean achievement is a 67.0.

Our scores remain consistent from SY2016.

We also have consistent achievement gaps between our white and black students.

Will be convening a gap team to create actionable items around the gaps we see between white and minoritized students. The team will meet every two weeks. The first meetings will focus on the data and the available resources that inform goal setting on closing achievement gaps.

Teachers have also been working on issues they see in the classroom around race -- are the gaps in report cards and student performances similar in the classroom as they are in standardized tests?

One of the different approaches that the team will add to the data dashboard will be the individual student assessments.

Will use the Atlas protocol to help determine how the individual classroom assessments affect student performance.

Rhiannen will report at next meeting about what the gap team discusses during their two meetings this month.

B. Lottery Process Update

Application period closes in two weeks. We are not on the same pace for the number of applications (900+ last year and 615 this year -- 115 from economically disadvantaged students and only 148 from tier one attendance zone).

Lottery on March 6th, and results published on March 7th.

Special call for the board to ratify the tier shifts and the weight.

C. Saturday School

Middle school students -- targeting those students who are in the middle of the road.
Elementary campus have a lot of teacher referrals.

Grades 3 and up.

Focus on grades three and up because we don't do a lot of test prep, and these students will be taking the milestones soon.

At the EC the Saturday classes focus on content skills and strategies.
