## II. Business \& Operations Update

## A. Edward Jones Investments Update

Paul Harrison of Edward Jones gave an update on the school's investment portfolio position. The school's investments are in good position and are generating a healthy yield.

## B. Financial Performance Update

Chiquetta West provided an update on the school's financial performance, revenue and expenditures through January 31, 2024.

- YTD revenue is $\$ 1.9 \mathrm{M}$ higher than the target, primarily due to the increased APS allocation, timing of CARES funds and nutrition grant receipts and MACAL program growth.
- YTD expenses are $\$ 0.7 \mathrm{M}$ higher than the target, primarily due to expenses incurred but not budgeted for including tenor bonus, stipends and staff retreat, timing of invoice payments, additional training costs and MACAL program growth.
- Aftercare and nutrition delinquency balance is $\$ 16 k$, which is lowest in the last five months.


## C. Facilities and Grounds

Alastair Pullen provided an update on the following improvements:

- permitting for the lift at the MC is in process
- discussions began with APS regarding the security vestibule plans
