

Charter goal: Students from economically disadvantaged households

- The weight for economically disadvantaged students will be calculated annually to ensure at least 40% of newly admitted students are economically disadvantaged. The Charter School will use the weighted lottery until 30% - 50% of enrolled students are economically disadvantaged.

Current state:

- 13% of the total student body is in the economically disadvantaged category
 - 9.2% of 401 elementary campus students
 - 18.6% of 237 middle campus students

Current applicant pool (window extends to March 2nd)

- 120 applications from economically disadvantaged families
 - 9 applications in the tier 1 attendance zone
 - Kindergarten: 2
 - 1st grade: 1
 - 2nd - 5th grade: 4
 - 6th grade: 2
 - 26 applications in the Jackson Cluster
 - Kindergarten: 7
 - 6th grade: 6
