Charter goal: Students from economically disadvantaged households

- The weight for economically disadvantaged students will be calculated annually to ensure at least $40 \%$ of newly admitted students are economically disadvantaged. The Charter School will use the weighted lottery until 30\% - $50 \%$ of enrolled students are economically disadvantaged.


## Current state:

- $13 \%$ of the total student body is in the economically disadvantaged category
- 9.2\% of 401 elementary campus students
$-18.6 \%$ of 237 middle campus students
