Socio-economic Diversity Goal

- Our charter petition sets our socio-economic diversity goal at 23% for economically disadvantaged families based on neighborhood data gathered at the time of the petition
- SY23 open seats = 72
- 23% of 72 = 17
- Goal = at least 17 of our newly admitted students are from economically disadvantaged households
