Superintendent Jill Burnes led board members and cabinet members in an opening activity. She shared with the group the Learning Targets for the day. Superintendent Burnes encouraged the Board to think about their individual "why" and their collective "why." Data was shared from a 2015 report, *The School Cliff Report* showing a downward trend of student engagement from grades through twelve. It was shared that this data has not significantly changed over the past 12 years. Superintendent Burnes shared a video by Ted Dintersmith titled, *Prepare our Kids for Life, Not Tests*.
