






NWEA MAP Fall 2023 - Value Schools Average:






All VS: Fall Across Years by Student Group - UPDATE






All VS: Fall Lexile Score by Grade Level






DVS: Fall 2023 by Grade Level **Students Performing At or Above Grade Level Expectations**






Annual Fall Performance: Students Above 40th Percentile



DVS: Fall Lexile Score by Grade Level







Annual Fall Performance: Students Above 40th Percentile






CCVHS: Fall 2023 by Grade Level **Students Performing At or Above Grade Level Expectations**






Annual Fall Performance: Students Above 40th Percentile



CCVHS: Fall Lexile Score by Grade Level





CCVHS: Fall Across Years by Student Group **On Grade Level Performance**





Dictionary of Educational Terms for Board Members

General Terms

- AB1505: An assembly bill passed by the state of California that defines how charters should be renewed.
- 2. **Charter Renewal:** All charter schools are authorized to continue operations by LAUSD. Renewals occur every 5 years, but schools who are underperforming may be renewed for 2 years or even face non-renewal.
- 3. **LAUSD Oversight Visits:** LA Unified School district is the authorizer of our charters. Every year, the LAUSD Charter School Division (CSD) will visit charter schools and provide them with an oversight report that measures our success.
- 4. LAUSD Oversight Report: An annual report provided to each charter school after the LAUSD oversight reports. LAUSD provides a 1-4 score in the following areas: Governance, Operations, Academics, and Finance. You may view an oversight report <u>here</u>.
- CSD: The Charter School Division is a division in LAUSD that oversees and makes recommendations to the LAUSD board for charter renewals.
- 6. LCAP: Local Control Accountability Plan
- 7. LCFF: Local Control Funding Formula
- 8. **LEA:** Local Education Agency. Group tasked with controlling or directing public education schools. All Value Schools are their own LEA.
- PS: Power School is our Student Information System (SIS) that houses all VS student data.
- 10. ADA: Average Daily Attendance
- 11. **SED:** Socially-economically Disadvantaged students.

Assessments and Measurements

- California School Dashboard: The California School Dashboard measures a school's progress from the prior year, as well as the current year academic results. To learn more about the California School Dashboard go here.
- 2. **Verified Data:** Data defined by state required to meet specific criteria as outlined by AB1505. This data is used for renewal criteria. Review criteria here.
- CAASPP: California Assessment of Student Performance & Progress. California's standardized test given to students in grades 3-8, and 11th grade every May. Many people also refer to this test as the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC).
- 4. **SBAC:** Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium. California's standardized testing. Same as CAASPP.
- 5. **DFS:** Distance from Standard. Learn more about Distance from Standard here.



- This measurement is used to project a school's progress on the California School Dashboard.
- NWEA: Northwest Evaluation Association provides all Value Schools with verified assessments and data that we are required to use for oversight and renewal purposes. To learn more about NWEA terms read here.
- 7. ELPAC English Language Proficiency Assessment for California (ELPAC):
 Assessment given to non-native English speakers to determine fluency in English.

Academic Terms

- 1. **ELA:** English Language Arts
- 2. **IEP:** Individual Education Plan Every student classified as a Student with Disability receives an IEP.
- 3. **SWD:** Students with Disabilities
- 4. SPED: Special Education
- 5. **EL:** English Learner (AKA English Language Learners or ELL)
- 6. **IFEP:** Initial Fluency English Proficient. Students who tested as Fluent on the initial ELPAC assessment are classified as IFEP.
- 7. **RFEP:** Reclassified Fluent English Proficient Students who were ELD when initially tested for English fluency and have since tested as English Fluent on the ELPAC since initial.
- 8. **LTEL:** Long term English Language Learners who have been in American schools for 6 years or longer without achieving proficiency to be reclassified.
- ELD English Language Development. Status is determined by English Language Proficiency Assessment for California (ELPAC) scores. Levels are ELD 1-4, 4 being proficient in English.

1. **ELOP**: Extended Learning Opportunity Plan.
