She added that the making health decisions, focusing on nutrition and food, fruits, portion control was very important.

Director Baassiri also spoke about how to make sure that we are engaging our students, helping them understand, expressing and making sure that they have the tools needed to make these choices to understand that what they put in their mouth can really affect how they are and how this can ultimately result into some chronic diseases.
