See the statement found on MCPSC's website and links to resources below for review. <b>"While this report references procedures related to charter revocation, it is provided as a standard requirement to ensure all schools are prepared for a range of scenarios.</b> In the event of revocation of a charter by MCPSC, schools must <b>ensure their board is aware of and prepared for the closure process.</b> This process is guided by a commitment to minimize disruption to students' education, to protect the public funds generated for educating students, and to preserve assets acquired through operation of the charter school.
