Dashboard

- One month of data - does not include running start
- SPED headcount reported 9 student in SPED - budget created on higher (30%)
 - capped at 16% per district
 - Must spend in line with intended use - SPED services
 - if don't spend all state will take them off - underspending last year
 - carry over some percentage of it but OSPI will recuperate
 - lose \$10,000 and roll the res from last year
 - The cap has been removed an expected to receive double
 - Have focus on SPED funding
- Public Revenue - around \$155k dispersed in 2 chunks in Oct then Mar/Apr
- less than \$1000 receipt missing this school year so far (from eric's credit card)
- New to dashboard - outstanding section
