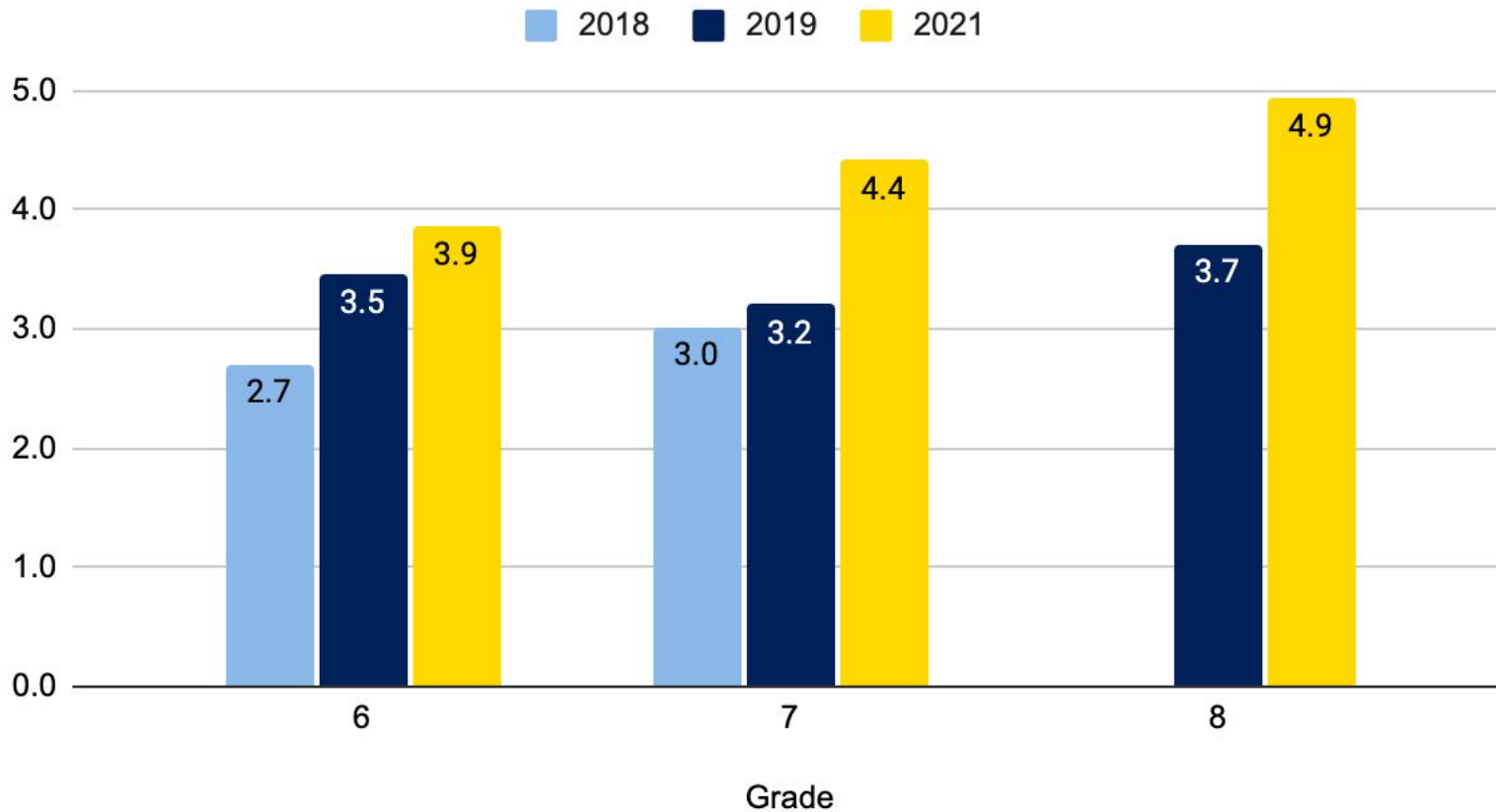

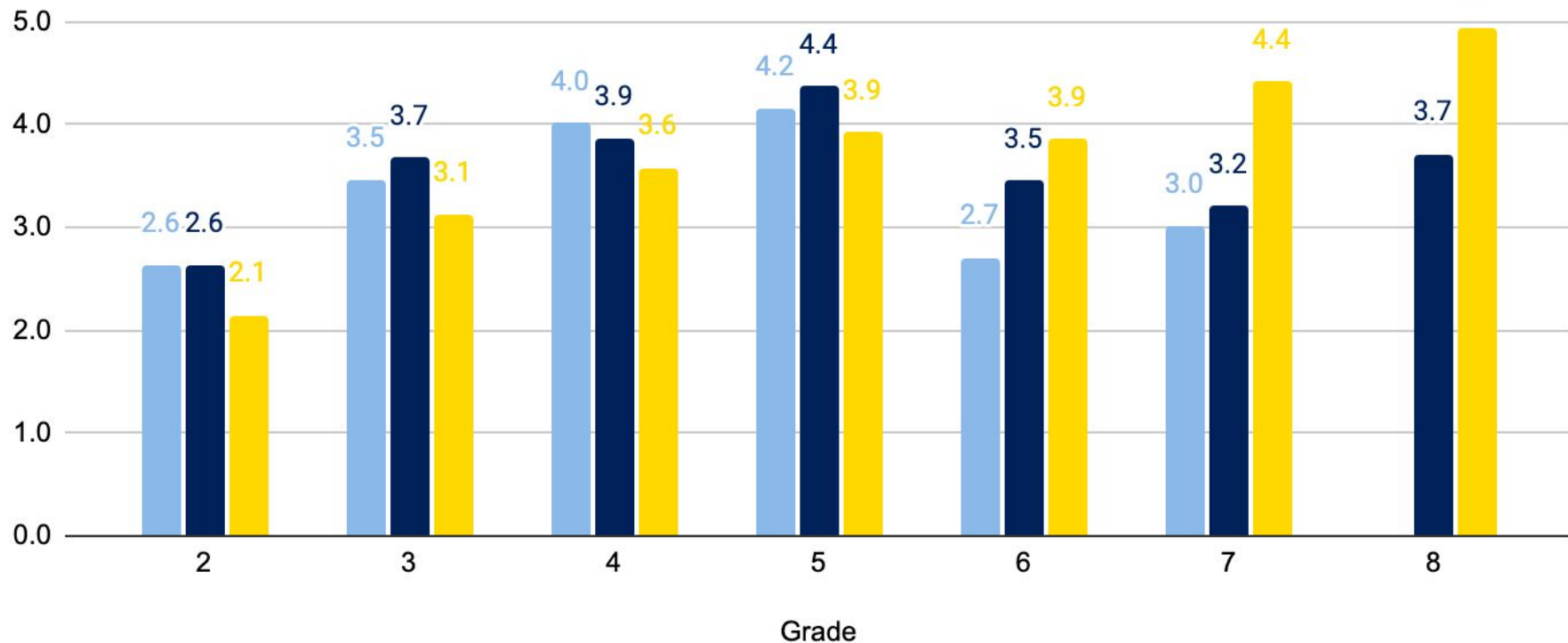

STAMP Avg Composite Level, by Grade and Year

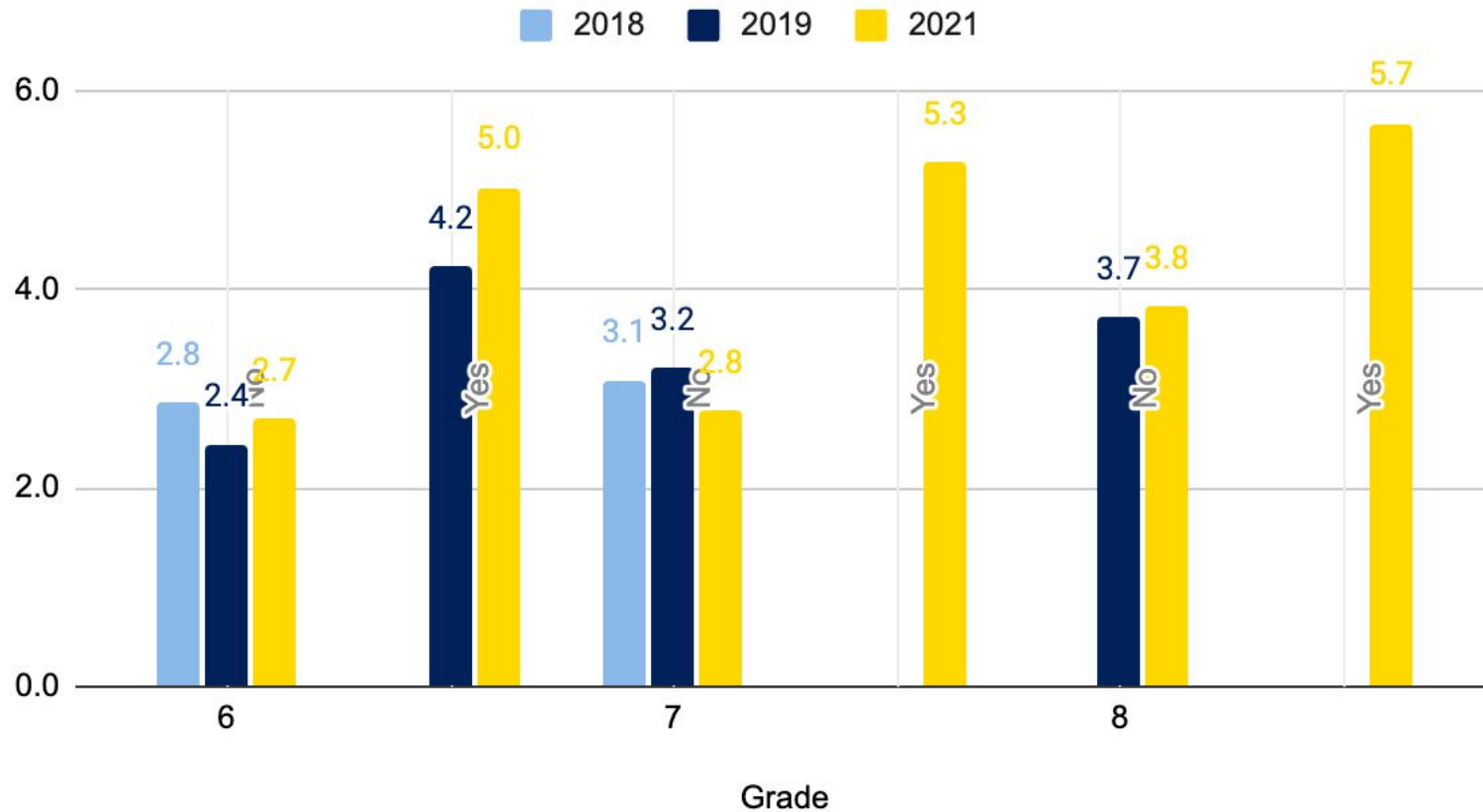


STAMP Avg Composite Level, by Grade and Year
