We will increase the number of K-8 students in the high growth/low achievement quadrant (fall to winter, winter to spring) by 5%, as measured by MAP Growth. (setting the baseline this year)

We will decrease the percentage by race/ethnicity of students scoring below the 60th percentile by 2% from the Spring '23 to Spring '24 administration, as measured by MAP. (Fall to Winter 2023 will be baseline)
