Proposed Board Recommendation

Propose that board approves the change order to authorize Dr. Caprice Young to sign the TMP Ramp solutions proposal.

Background

Magnolia Public Schools is developing a new school facility for MSA San Diego, a middle school campus for up to 450 students on the campus formerly known as the DeAnza School on land that is leased from the San Diego Unified School District. 18 modular classrooms, two restrooms and corresponding ramps were purchased by Williams Scotsman, Inc. A recent discovery revealed that the current ramp choice would not work for the modular buildings.

We have been in contact with TMP Services, a modular stair and platform company with DSA approval, which has proposed a solution of custom aluminum ramps and stairs that are made to order and meet all accessibility provisions. They have provided a quote of approximately \$147,518.37 for the ramps and stairs. TMP can produce and deliver the products in two weeks from the issuance of the NTP, which Magnolia should be able to execute by the end of the week, pending board approval. The team has decided to move forward with TMP to keep the project moving forward.

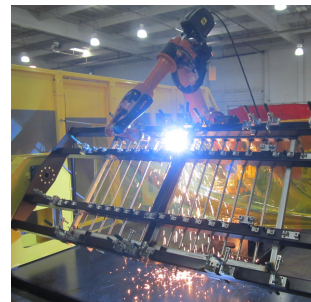

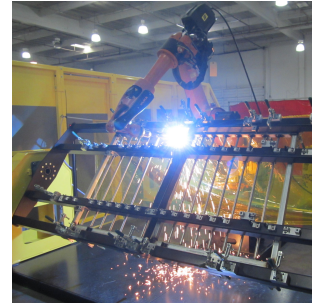

Proposed Board Recommendation
