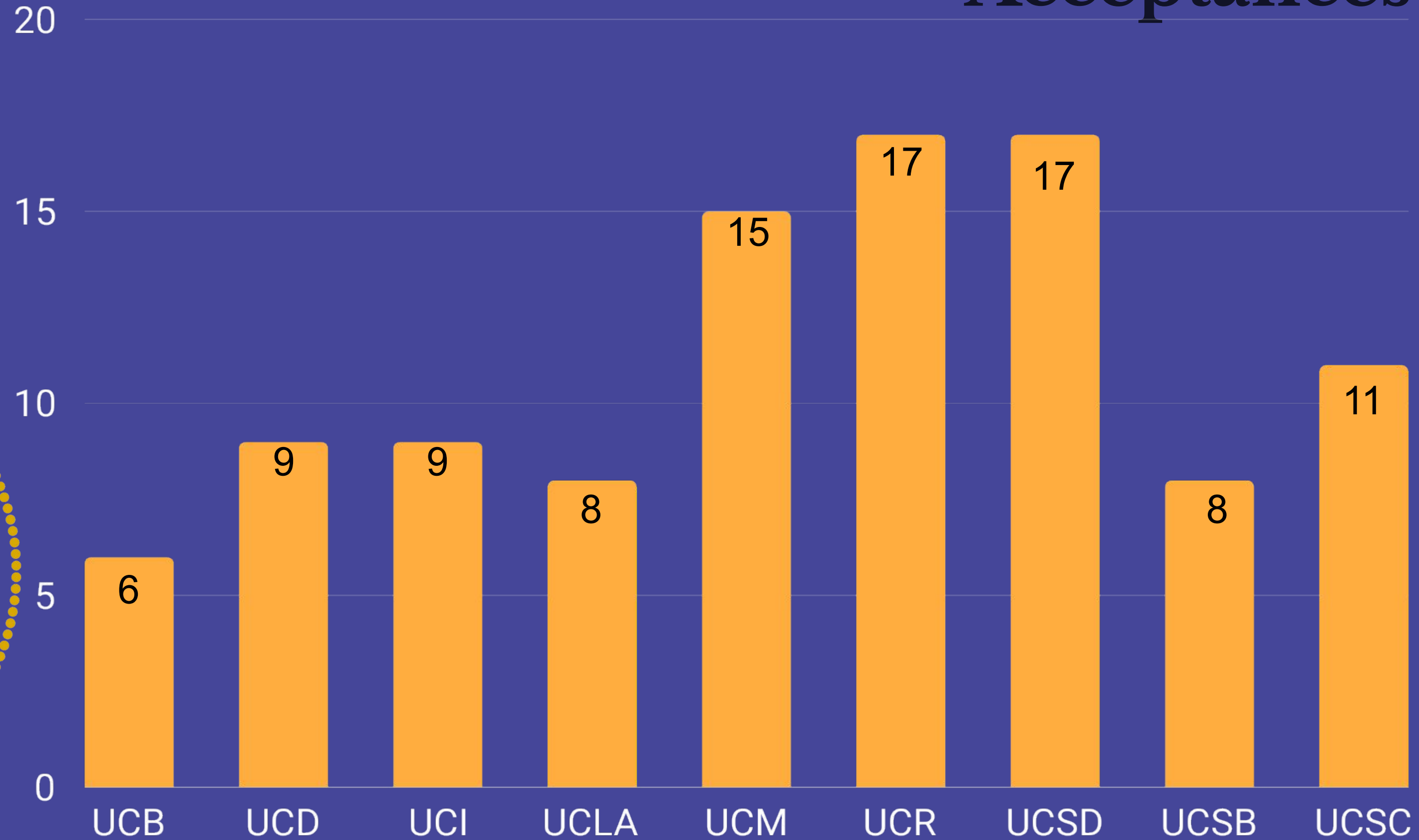

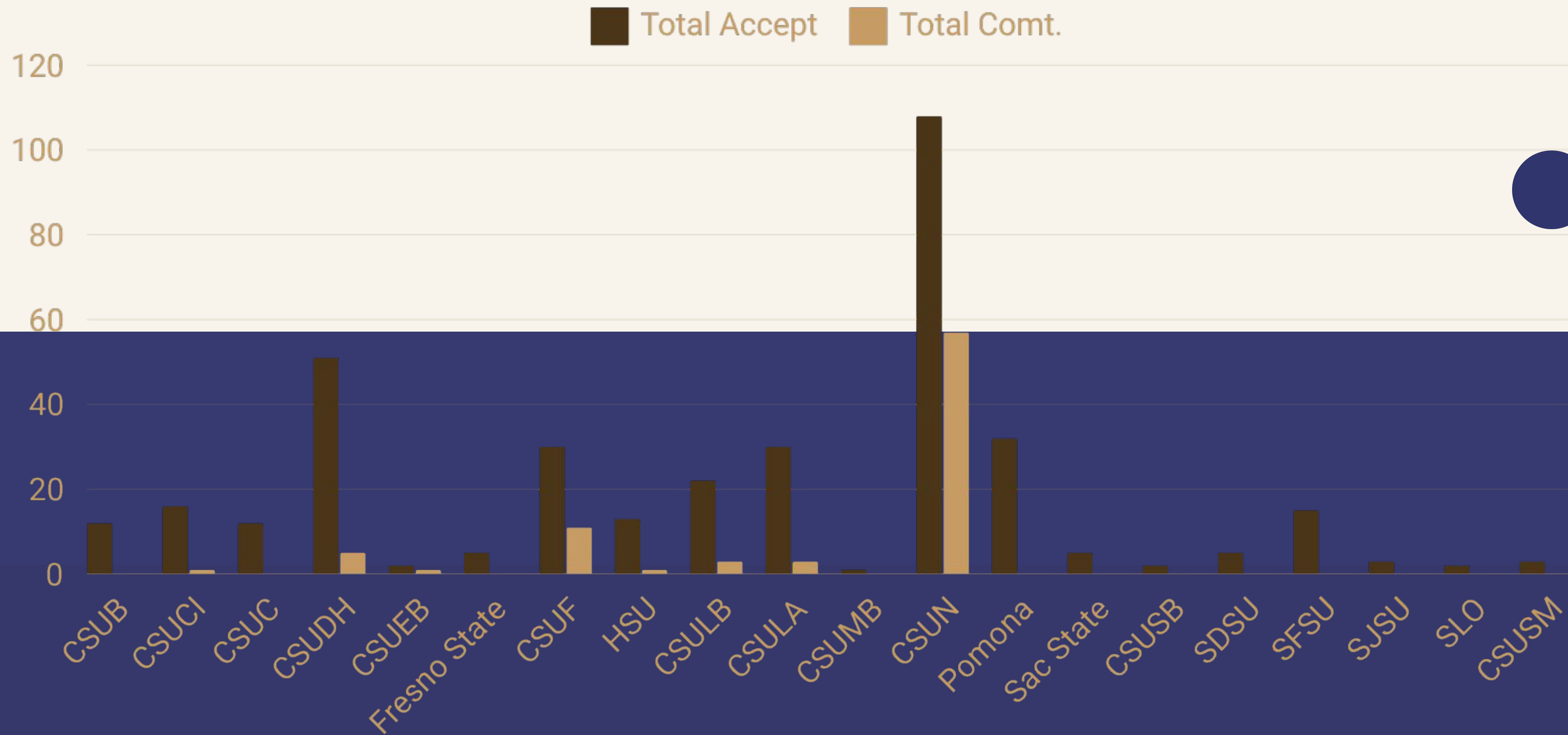

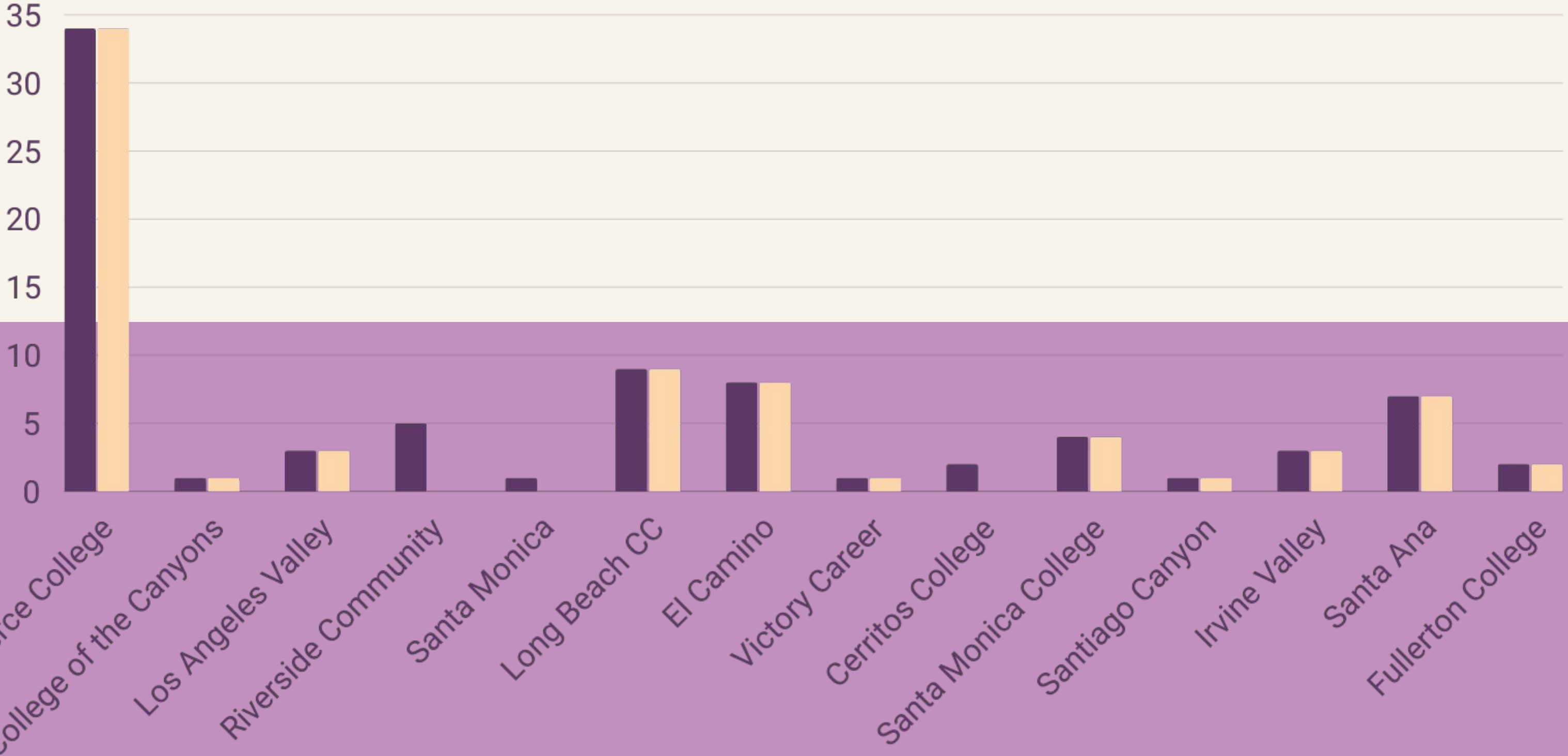

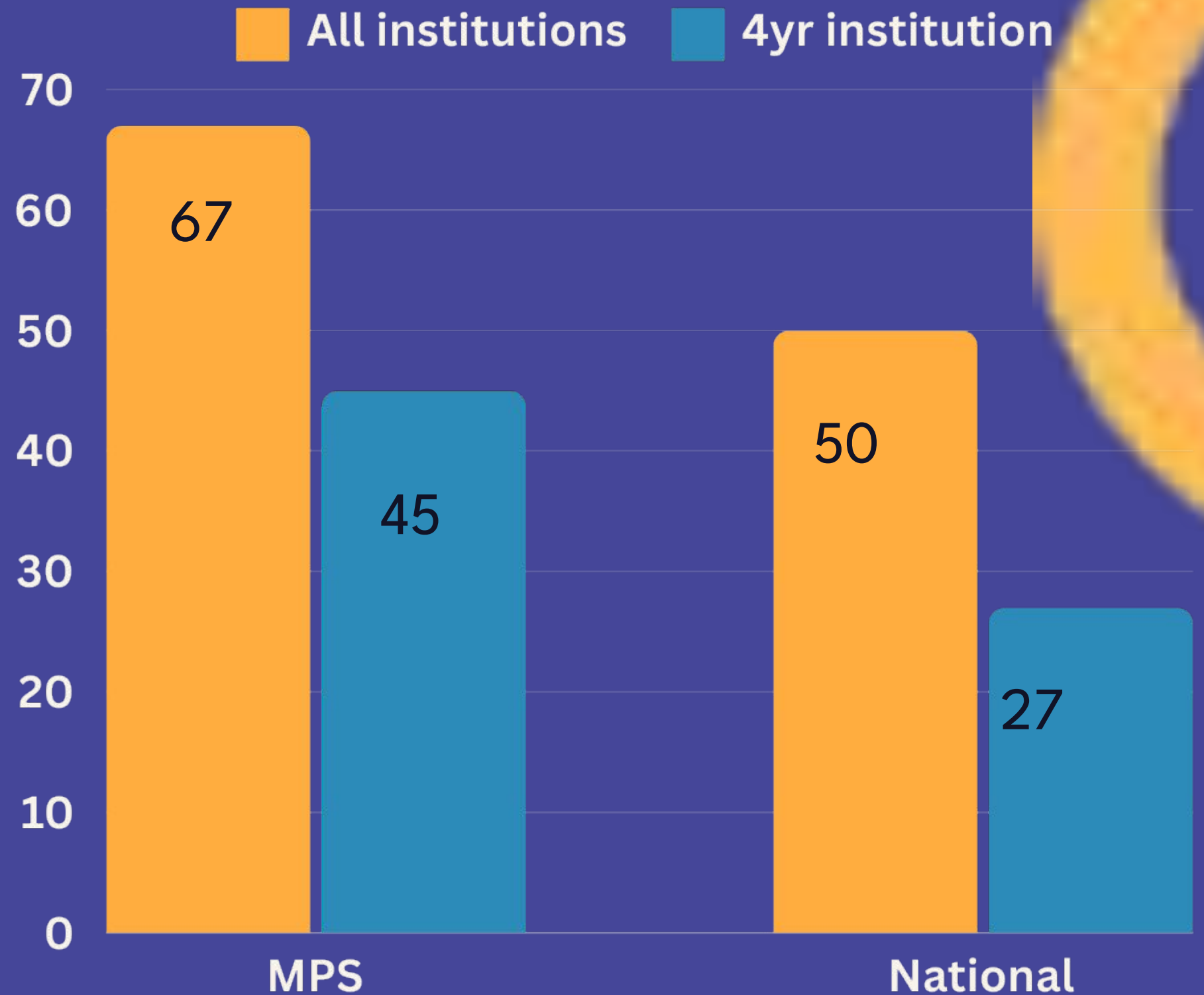

COLLEGE ENROLLMENT

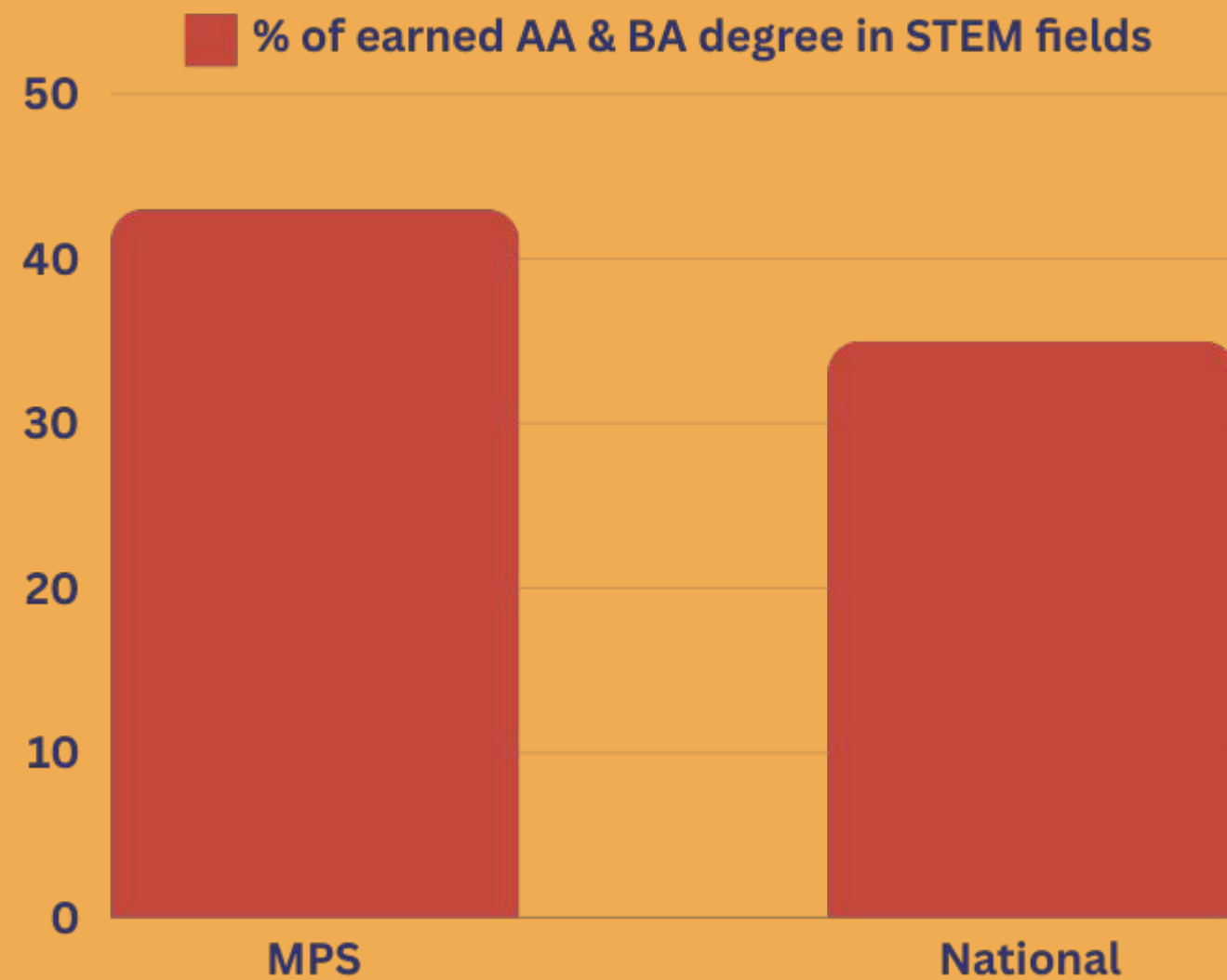
Magnolia graduates were 20% more likely to enroll in college than students from similar schools in the U.S.



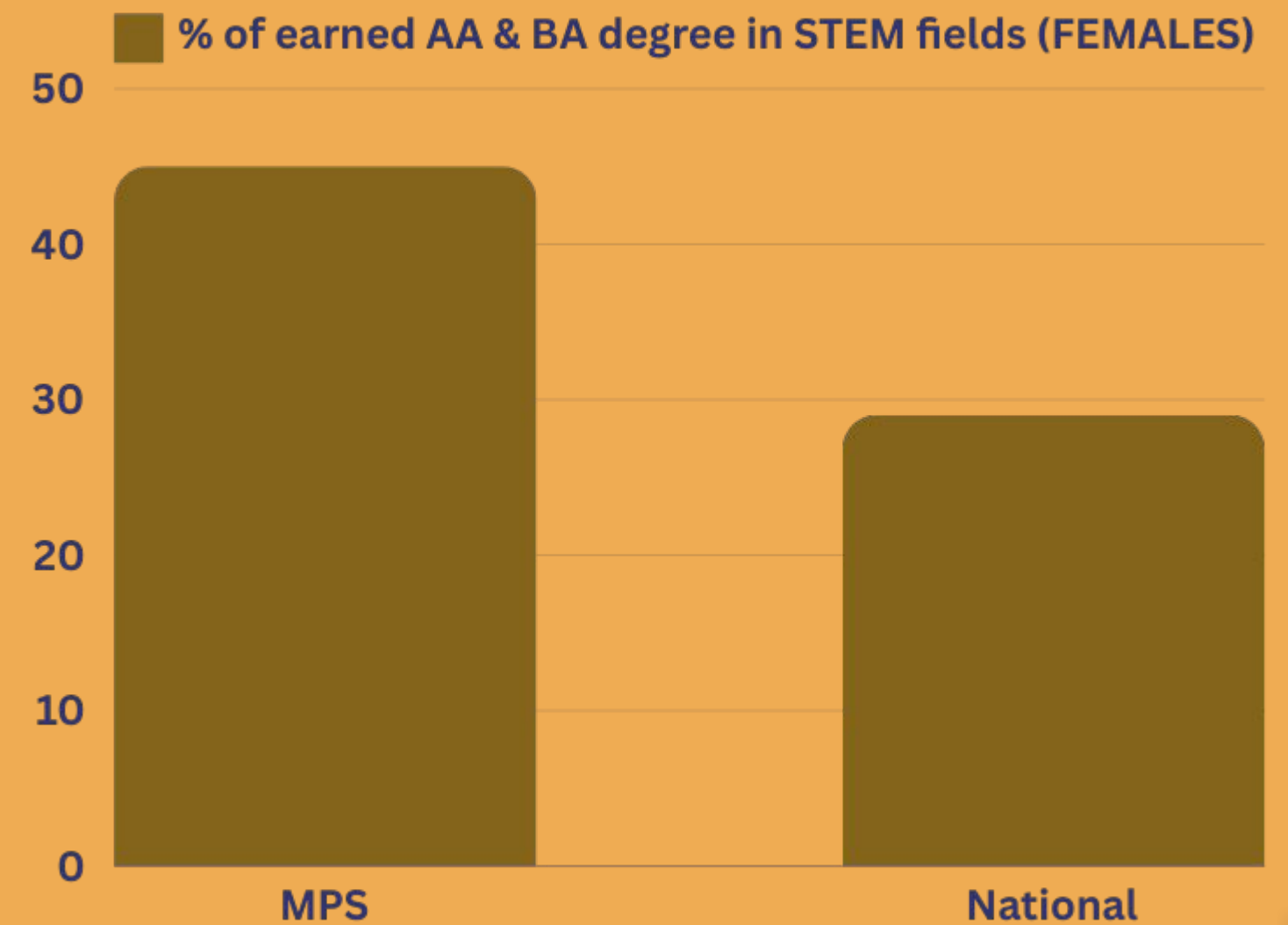
College Enrollment after high school

STEM DEGREE PURSUIT



Magnolia alumni were 22% more likely to study in a STEM field than other college graduates.



Female Magnolia alumni were 54% more likely to graduate from a STEM field than their non-Magnolia peers.

College and Career Program
