Proposed Board Recommendation

Background

The Interactive Display is a need for the daily classroom teaching needs. We will be using Touchscreen Interactive Displays in 11 classrooms at MSA Santa Ana by replacing regular projectors for presentation. The quality of the image, it’s interactive feature, and it’s compatibility with peripherals like Apple TV and Chromecast is the main advantages over regular projectors.
