Here are the answers to your questions that I received. Please let me know if you have any questions.

- 1. Has there been significant change to ADA from the P-Annual since 2019 to 2020 estimated No
- 2. Are there additional factored receivables during the year ended 6/30/2021? All schools are anticipated to factor receivables due to state LCFF deferrals.
- 3. Is there new debt (such as PPP loans) or other debt during the year ended 6/30/2021? Yes. Except for Clarksville, ALL schools have PPP loans.
