Code of Conduct

 Purpose: As we enter our third year, we have identified the need to adopt a separate consequence matrix for our kindergarten students compared to our lower and upper elementary students.

Why a separate matrix for kindergarten?

Kindergarten students are at a very different developmental stage than older elementary students. They are still learning foundational social, emotional, and behavioral skills—such as impulse control, emotional regulation, and appropriate school behavior.

As a result, they require:

- More frequent reminders to reinforce expectations.
- Increased opportunities for reteaching behaviors before consequences escalate.
- Developmentally appropriate consequences that prioritize learning and skillbuilding rather than punitive measures.

Having a differentiated approach allows us to maintain high expectations for all students while meeting kindergartners where they are developmentally and setting them up for long-term success. The proposal can be found <u>HERE</u>.
