1. Enrollment status- current status & School Attendance

Enrollment w/ currently 125 students + 70 new applications= 195 total

Enrollment by grade: 47 K, 36 1st, 25 2nd, 19 3rd

Goal for SY25-26 of 200 students

Daily Attendance: K- 91.3% (\uparrow 2%), 1st- 94%(\uparrow 1%), 2nd- 91.2%(\downarrow 1%), and 3rd- 93%(\downarrow 1%)

- 2. Personnel Updates- Updates on staffing and updates regarding professional development of staff. 23 flight crew (9 flight captains,5 co-captains,4 staff support, 4 flight control, 4 contractors). Students unable to complete K fluency passage ("A Fox") in grades 1-3, given word walls in classroom and sent home with high freq word lists for spelling and enrichment packets.
