Professional Development

Mr. Garcia, our Coordinator of Instruction, continues to work with teachers on Professional Development focusing on our school data with an emphasis on how we are providing support to our SPED and EL students. We are now focusing on the SBAC exam and making sure we allocate as much time as possible for preparation and practice for the exam. We currently have re-grouped our Advisory Classes by grade so that we can ensure the support that each grade individually needs whether it be ELA or Math.

Parent Meetings

The BCCHS School Advisory Council continues to meet and provide information to our stakeholders. As vital members of our BCCHS community, we value their input to make our school and community a great success.

On Tuesday, April 9th, BCCHS hosted its 2nd Annual Days of Dialogue with LAPD. This meeting was well attended by our parents and students to have discussion with local law enforcement regarding concerns in our community.

On, Wednesday, April 10th, we hosted a meeting for 11th grade parents to inform them of the upcoming SBAC exam and the need to have them support us in making sure their students are prepared. At the meeting, parents were provided with data that shows their students progress from the practice exams and the need to do well in the upcoming exam.

On Thursday, April 25th, we will be hosting another community meeting for parents to inform them of the current issues of gang recruitment and drugs around the school community. We will be partnering with Bert Corona Charter and Macaly MS to inform parents of the current situation that our community is facing.

CTE Grant

We are currently in the final stages of the CTE Grant and purchasing our new equipment. In total, BCCHS was awarded \$139,265.67 from this grant. We have purchased new computers, cameras and

equipment that will be used to support our students to enter the CTE program and be ready to obtain a certification from LAMC or even a degree in the Media and visual arts industry.
