



YPI Charter Schools Handwriting Policy AB 446

Newsom signed a law requiring cursive handwriting to be taught in California schools. Governor Gavin Newsom signed AB 446, which requires California schools to teach cursive to first through sixth-grade elementary students. The YPICS Board acknowledges this change in statute. YPI Charter Schools will include this course requirement during the English Language Arts Courses for students in 5th and 6th grades.
