Resolution No. 1 (2021-2022) Continuing Board of Trustees Authority to Hold Virtual Meetings Pursuant to AB 361

WHEREAS, on or about March 4, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom declared a statewide emergency arising from the coronavirus (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, on or about March 17, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 suspending certain provisions of the Brown Act pertaining to teleconferenced meetings; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2021, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-08-21 which indicated that Executive Order N-29-20's authorization for holding virtual meetings would expire on September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361 (Rivas), which provides that legislative bodies may continue to meet remotely during a declared State of Emergency subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, AB 361 amends the Brown Act (Government Code section 54953) to add the following provision:

(e)(1) A local agency may use teleconferencing without complying with the requirements of paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) if the legislative body complies with the requirements of paragraph (2) of this subdivision in any of the following circumstances:

(B) The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.;

(C) The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency and has determined, by majority vote, pursuant to subparagraph (B), that, as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.; and

WHEREAS, AB 361 amends the Brown Act (Government Code section 54953) to add the following provision:

(e)(3) If a state of emergency remains active, or state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, in order to continue to



teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b), the legislative body shall, not later than 30 days after teleconferencing for the first time pursuant to subparagraph (A), (B), or (C) of paragraph (1), and every 30 days thereafter, make the following findings by majority vote:

(A) The legislative body has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency.

(B) Any of the following circumstances exist:

(i) The state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Palisades Charter High School finds that the Governor's March 4, 2020 declaration of a state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic remains active.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of the Palisades Charter High School finds that, due to the state of emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees and/or the state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person due to a recent significant increase in positive COVID-19 cases in the PCHS community; and due to the prevalence of new variants, the indoor setting of meeting facilities, the potential presence of unvaccinated individuals attending meetings, the potential for noncompliance with mask wearing requirements including PCHS' reinstituted indoor mask mandate following the recent rise in cases, and the desire to protect the health of immuno-compromised trustee(s), staff and the public.

BEFORE THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE PALISADES CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL

RESOLUTION NO. 2 (2021-2022)

CLASSIFIED LAYOFF

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Palisades Charter High School ("PCHS") has determined it necessary to eliminate the classified positions set forth below for the 2022-23 school year due to lack of funds pursuant to Education Code sections 45117 and 45308; and

WHEREAS, the Education Code generally requires that various actions be taken and notices be forwarded no later than March 15th of each school year regarding layoffs of classified personnel; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 45117(g) provides that when classified positions must be eliminated as a result of the expiration of a specially funded program, the employees to be laid off shall be given written notice not less than 60 days prior to the effective date of their layoff informing them of their layoff date and their displacement rights, if any, and reemployment rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Trustees of the Palisades Charter High School hereby determines that the following classified positions shall be eliminated for lack of funds:

<u>POSITION</u> Paraprofessional/Special Education Assistant

ELIMINATED Eliminate four (4) special, categorically funded positions

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Palisades Charter High School as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct;
- 2. The services being performed in the classified positions set forth hereinabove shall be eliminated and as a result of said action, affected classified employees shall be laid off due to lack of funds;
- 3. Said elimination of a classified positions shall become effective sixty (60) days after the affected classified employees receive written notice of layoff;
- 4. The Executive Director or her designee is directed to give sixty (60) days' notice of layoff to affected classified employees (considering displacement or "bumping" rights) as set forth in the Education Code, including sections 45298 and 45308, where applicable;
