Mask Protocol

*Students must wear masks at all times when indoors while on campus. Before being admitted onto campus, students must complete and pass the PCHS Health Check each day. The Health Check from now until 7/31/2022 consists of verbal questions about COVID-19 exposure and symptoms. However, the PCHS Health Check is subject to change to be more or less stringent at any time. The specific requirements of the PCHS Health Check for Orientation and the start of school are still TBD at this time.

Students attending in-person will receive temporary PCHS ID cards and register with the cafeteria and <u>IF</u> your student is planning to bring their own computer device (non-phone) to Pali, be sure it complies with the PCHS student device requirements (which can be found on our website), and MAKE SURE to have them bring the device to orientation. PCHS conducts most testing online using a computer/laptop. In order for students to use their own device at PCHS, they will be required to install the <u>Respondus</u> <u>LockDown Browser</u>. Our technology team will assist with the installation at the Tech Table. Please note

that students must have administrative rights to their laptops to install the software. Without the Respondus LockDown Browser installed, your student will not be able to use that personally owned device at PCHS.

FOR 9^{III} GRADE & *NEW Incoming 10-12^{III} GRADE ORIENTATION ONLY:

- Students **should plan on arriving early** to sign in and register themselves for Orientation day. This process will begin at **8:30 AM** for freshmen and **1:00 PM** for NEW 10-12th grade students.
- Students will need to bring their personal computing device to complete the Respondus LockDown Browser installation.
- Orientation begins **promptly** at **9:00 AM** in the large gym and will end at **1:00 PM for freshmen** and **promptly** at **1:30 PM** in the large gym and will end at **3:30 PM for** NEW 10-12th grade students! This is not a come-and-go orientation day. Students will need to remain on campus from start to finish.



• All in-person students will participate in fun, small group activities.

- If you have already registered and paid for Transportation/Busing to Pali during the school year, please visit the Transportation Office to obtain your mandatory Aug Bus Sticker. You MUST have your temporary PCHS ID before getting your Bus Sticker!

- The first day of school is Wednesday, August 17, 2022. Please ensure that your student arrives ON TIME, which means at least 15–20 Minutes before the 8:30 AM start Time. Students will attend all classes. Please remind your 10th, 11th, or 12th graders to complete the summer reading assignment. 9th graders are not required to complete a summer reading assignment. - Attendance Matters! The attendance policy that was suspended by the PCHS Board of Trustees due to the pandemic will be reinstated for the 2022-2023 school year pending the PCHS Board of Trustees' approval. Beginning the 2nd week of school, all students will begin to be marked tardy (3 Tardies = 1 Absence).
- Temporary IDs will be issued during orientation and the first week of school. Pictures for permanent IDs will be taken on August 24th and 25th during the school day.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

- Cash to purchase PE clothes (optional) (\$15 Shorts, \$15 Shirt) & pay off any fines/fees
- Personal device (Laptop, Chromebook) for Respondus LockDown Browser software installation *This is MANDATORY if your student plans on using their personal device for the school year.
