Information Technology:

- Provided setups for 13 scheduled student & faculty events and closed 143 tickets
- Repaired 14 Student Devices
- Continuing to assist all department offices with data collection/report writing in Infinite Campus
- Assisted Faculty with submission of Fall Semseter grades. Highest rate of timely submissions in two years.
- Provided Faculty PD covering IC and Schoology Gradebook Setup on Spring Semester in-service day. Extremely
 well received. Multiple requests for continued technical oriented trainings received.

Permits & Setups:

- Permit Revenue for December 2023 is: \$40,217.00
 - o \$29,417.00 from Facility Rentals
 - o \$500.00 from Facility Parking Rental
 - o \$1,500.00 from One-Time Rentals
 - o \$5,300.00 from Banner Rentals
 - \$3,500.00 from Filming
- Banner demand continues to be strong.
- Permits—Steady use into the Winter Season. PCHS Winter athletics kicking in. It will affect revenue due to game cancellations, etc.
- Baseball field CLOSED for Annual Reseeding/Renovations –due to open for Permitting 1/29
- Small and Large Gym Were CLOSED December 18th for 2 weeks for Annual Resurfacing
 - **Permit revenue will dip in the months following it will correct itself mid-January/February.

- Potential Filming for Jan. –Still Photo Commercial (Jan 25th), Dick's Sporting Goods Still Photo (Jan 27th OR 28th).
