Key Questions for the Outcomes Committee to Address:

- What metric would best capture student engagement and growth in OER performance?
- What feels like an ambitious but achievable goal for student participation?
- Should we differentiate expectations across grade levels?
- What percentage of our literacy resources should go to tier 1 vs. tier 2?
- How do we ensure tier 1 improvements actually reduce tier 2 needs?
- What investments are highest leverage at this moment in time?

Key Questions for the Outcomes Committee to Address:

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- While 4-year access remains a strong point, is there one place within this pipeline (application, acceptance, matriculation) that we should intervene more deeply next year?
- How do we grapple with 2-year affordability and underrepresented minority (URM) grad rates impact how we think about 4-year matriculation?
- We have not conducted a “white paper” analysis of alumni persistence factors since 2019. If we were to analyze this again, what sorts of questions or indicators would we want to track?
