<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• While 4-year access remains a strong point, is there one place within this pipeline (application, acceptance, matriculation) that we should intervene more deeply next year?</li> <li>• How do we grapple with 2-year affordability and underrepresented minority (URM) grad rates impact how we think about 4-year matriculation?</li> <li>• We have not conducted a “white paper” analysis of alumni persistence factors since 2019. If we were to analyze this again, what sorts of questions or indicators would we want to track?</li> </ul>
