Speakers may be called in the order requests are received. Comments are limited to 2 minutes each, with no more than 15 minutes per single topic. If a member of the public utilizes a translator to address the School Board or Committee, as applicable, those members of the public are allotted 4 minutes each to accommodate translation time.

By law, the School Board or Committee, as applicable, is allowed to take action only on items on the agenda. However, the School Board or Committee, as applicable, may, at its discretion, refer a matter to school staff or calendar the issue for future discussion.
