Reasons:

February (Board Approval)

- The school took on the responsibility of paying all staff during COVID 19 closures
- The school was closed from at least March 13 to May 15
- This is a saving of \$6,000+ (which could be as high as \$16,000 if we do not resume school and thus not have to pay out any more substitute funding)
- · This will help offset costs related to the closure and help reduce the potential deficit at the end of the school year

#### § 143-318.11. Closed sessions.

(a) Permitted Purposes. - It is the policy of this State that closed sessions shall be held only when required to permit a public body to act in the public interest as permitted in this section. A public body may hold a closed session and exclude the public only when a closed session is required:

• To establish, or to instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating (i) the price and other material terms of a contract or proposed contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange, or lease; or (ii) the amount of compensation and other material terms of an employment contract or proposed employment contract.
